He was appointed to the Pontifical Academy for Life of Vatican City and as a Consultor to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops. He graduated from the Honors Program of Boston College and earned a Ph.D. four years later from the [University of Notre Dame](#). A Fulbright Scholar, Dr. Kaczor is a former Federal Chancellor Fellow at the [University of Cologne](#) and William E. Simon Visiting Fellow in the [James Madison Program](#) at Princeton University. He is the author of 14 books and over 50 scholarly articles.
