Welcome to 2018-19 Religious Education Year!

Confirmation Information for High School: 9th & 10th Grade Students & Parent/Guardians: The goal of this preparation process is to strengthen the Christian's baptismal call to discipleship. After a three year process of preparation, candidates who are ready to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation are presented to the Bishop, requesting that they be fully initiated into the Catholic Church. Readiness is achieved in several ways: knowledge and understanding of the Sacrament and the gifts of the Holy Spirit as well as general knowledge and practice of the teachings of the Catholic Church. Candidates are expected to begin preparation in their ninth and tenth grade years by participating in the following each year:

***Attend Saturday/Sunday Eucharist weekly**
(Sunday Eucharist is central to our belief and practice as Catholics)

***Attend one retreat each year with Holy Rosary Youth Ministry**

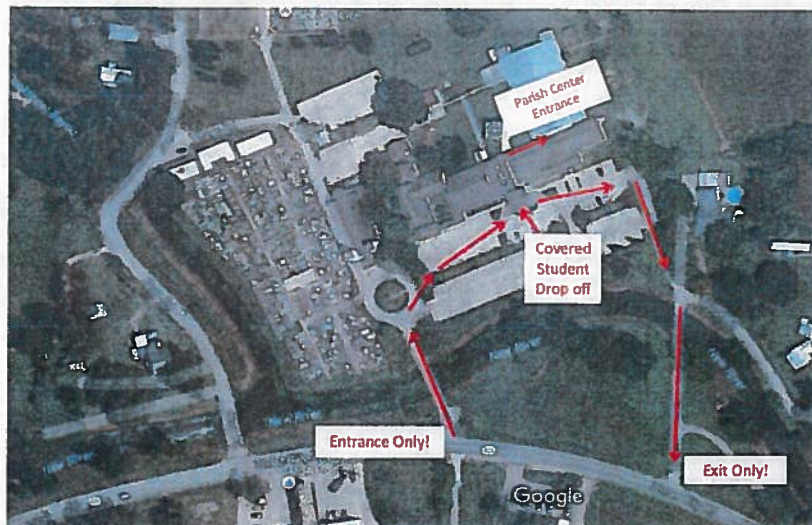

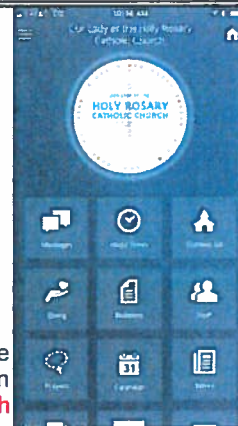

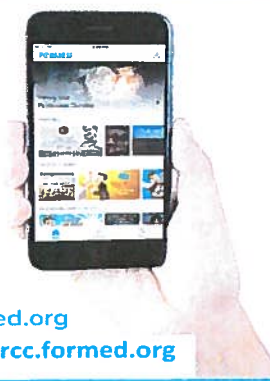


After downloading the App, press the three lines in the upper left hand corner, click on notifications and turn on notifications for **9th** and **10th grade**.
