I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth; and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilot, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead, He ascended into heaven, sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty; from thence He shall come to judge the living and the dead. *I believe in the Holy Spirit the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of Saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.*

Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name, Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven. *Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. Amen.*

Hail Mary

Hail Mary full of grace, the Lord is with Thee, blessed art thou amongst women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. *Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen*

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. *As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.*

Fatima Prayer

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell and lead all souls to heaven especially those most in need of Thy mercy.

Prayer for Priest to be said after the Fatima Prayer

(ALL) *God, our Father, please send us holy priests, all for the Sacred and Eucharistic Heart of Jesus, all for the sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, all in union with Saint Joseph.*

The Luminous Mysteries

1. The Baptism in the Jordan

Jesus descends into the water of the Jordan River and is baptized by John. The heavens open and the voice of the Father declares Him the beloved Son. The Spirit descends upon Jesus and fills Him with God's mission to save humankind from sin.

(ALL) *We pray for all priest; that they be lifted up and strengthened by the Holy Spirit for their public ministry. We pray that priests always are assured of God's permanent relationship with His people and celebrate in gratitude for the gift of faith.*

(Prayer for Priest)

2. The Wedding at Cana

Jesus changes water into wine at the request of Mary, who was first among believers. The disciples witness this miracle, their hearts open to the faith, and they begin to believe in Him.

(ALL) *We pray that just as Mary was there at the beginning of Her Son's public ministry; that all priest are assured and hold in their hearts the fact that She remains for all time for all priests as their special intercessor and guide. We pray that priest are always reminded and guided by the image of Mary's fidelity to Her Son and Jesus' fidelity to Her.*

(Prayer for Priest)

3. Proclamation of the Kingdom of God

Jesus proclaims the coming of the Kingdom of God, calls to conversion and forgives sins of all who draw near to him in humble trust.

(ALL) *We pray that all priest are blessed by this call to conversion and inspired by the graces they receive to live lives of holiness. We pray that when priest feel helpless or in need that they are always reminded that God's kingdom is at hand and reminded of God's mystery of mercy and reconciliation.*

(Prayer for Priest)

4. The Transfiguration

On Mount Tabor, the Apostles see the glory of God shining forth from the face of Jesus. The voice of the Father commands the Apostles "This is my chosen Son, listen to Him"

(ALL) *We pray that all priest be likewise transformed by the grace of the Holy Spirit and lifted up by the awesome presence of God in their lives. We pray also that priest be always assured that His mercy endures forever.*

(Prayer for Priest)

5. The Institution of the Eucharist

At the Last Supper, Jesus offer His body and blood, through the bread and wine, and washes the feet of the Apostles. Jesus testifies to His everlasting love for each one of us by sharing the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

(ALL) *We pray that the gift & graces of the joy of consecrating simple bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ be spiritual fuel to nurture and strengthen priest' lives. We pray that priest manifest their love of the Eucharistic Lord as they live their lives as "persona Christi" for us.*

Hail Holy Queen

*Hail, Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life,
our sweetness and our hope, to Thee do we
cry, poor banished children of Eve, to Thee
do we send up our sighs, mourning and
weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then,
most Gracious Advocate, thine eyes of mercy
towards us, and after this our exile, show
unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb Jesus,
O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary.*

**Pray for us Oh Holy Mother of God That
we may be made worthy of the promises of
Christ. Let us pray, O God, whose only
begotten Son, by His life, death and
resurrection, has purchased for us the
rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech
Thee, that while meditating on these
mysteries of the most Holy Rosary of the
Blessed Virgin Mary, we may imitate what
they contain and obtain what they promise
through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen.**

Closing Prayer for Priest (ALL)

*Gracious and loving God, we thank You for
the gift of our priests. Through them, we
experience Your presence in the sacraments.
Help our priest to be strong in their vocation.
Set their souls on fire with love for your
people. Grant them the wisdom,
understanding, and strength they need to
follow in the footsteps of Jesus. Inspire them
with the vision of your Kingdom. Give them
the words they need to spread the Gospel.
Allow them to experience joy in their
ministry. Help them to become instruments of
your Divine Grace. We ask this through
Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns as our
Eternal Priest. Amen.*
