- Check-in begins at 7:30 am. The program starts promptly at 8:00 am.
- All retreatants receive a shirt. You will be able to pick-up your retreat shirt at any Mass this weekend. All shirts not picked up this weekend will be here waiting for you when you arrive for the retreat. We encourage everyone to wear your shirt to the retreat. Dress comfortably, but keep in mind we will be in the church for Mass and prayer.
- You are asked to bring a bible that you are comfortable with using. If you forget yours or need a bible, no worries, we will have some available. We will provide a tote bags/journals/pens and any other supplies.
- When you arrive, you can park on the far right-side of the campus. The retreat will begin in our Parish Center building. If you park in the front lot, walk through the covered walkway between the buildings. The Parish Center is the large metal building on your right. Team members will be there to greet you at the door.
- Breakfast, lunch, dinner, drinks, and snacks will be provided throughout the day. We have noted any special dietary needs listed on your registration.
- Everyone will attend 4:00 Mass together and will be seated as a group. This is not the end of the retreat though. We ask that you plan to stay until the closing prayer, which should finish around 7:00 pm.
