

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Due to the precautions in place at this time, our Faith Formation programs will utilize Google Classroom to some degree this year. In order to access Google Classroom an email address from the parish email domain (@saintjulies.org) is required.

The Diocese of Fall River has strict guidelines in place to ensure the safety of your children. Adult staff and volunteers are never to email a minor. Therefore, email addresses from the @saintjulies.org domain are being sent to **you**, the parent or guardian, so that **you** can log your child into Google Classroom for their Faith Formation class.

An email address from the Saint Julie's email domain (@saintjulies.org) will be created for each student registered in our Faith Formation program. The invitation to the email will be sent to the parent/guardian. Upon receiving the invitation to our parish email domain **parents have 48 hours in which they can accept the invitation** and create a unique password. (Fun fact: You will notice that a number is included in the email address. This number indicates the year in which your child began grade 1. This system will help us to clear out email addresses for students who have completed grade 9.)

The @saintjulies.org email addresses are intended for Faith Formation use only. Each email address will be "suspended" at the end of the Faith Formation year and renewed when the student is registered in the Fall of 2021. (I believe passwords will remain the same.)
