### **Decisions Made:**

- **Building Update**—church will be available for training in February.
- **Dedication Rite**—Invitations need to be sent to priests who we would like to be present (past pastors, those who were raised in Beaver Dam, etc.) During the dedication rite, the sacred relics will be presented. They will be covered with a red cloth and flanked by two candles.
- **Creation of a collectable worship aid for the dedication rite;** it should include an explanation of the rite of dedication, explanation of the liturgical items, history of items from the 3 parishes, significance of what is in the rite, and a letter from the Bishop. The gospel of Matthew was chosen as the gospel reading ( Upon this rock, I will build a church). The worship aid should also include the names of the groups associated with the parish.
- **Stations of the Cross:** A set of the Stations of the Cross which are wood cuts were donated by Jerry Kamps. Discussion on placement of them was had.
- **Training dates for the lay ministries in the new church were set as follows:**  
Lectors—February 16 at 1 pm  
Eucharistic Ministers—February 23 at 1 pm  
Ushers—February 22 at 10 am  
Servers—February 23 at 6 pm  
On January 31 at 1 pm the entire Liturgy Committee will walk through the church to decide on flow for distribution of the Eucharist.
