Discussion on Statues and Artwork: Discussion was had on getting quotes for consignment on the statues and artwork that was discussed at our last meeting. Coletta had a discussion with the sales representative from Stempers. The following are items which we wish to place on consignment:

Resurrected Jesus

Large St. Katharine Drexel picture

Small Mother of Perpetual Help

Small Black Madonna

Small St. Theresa

Gold Holy Spirit

Tabernacle (we have 2 tabernacles (one wooden one and one traveling one)

Candelabras (we have one set of 3, 1 set of 5 and 2 sets of 7). The small one could be used in the Eucharistic Chapel.

Stempers will not take the old glassware.

The St. Michael statue is in need of repair. It is estimated that it would cost \$2500.00 to repair and paint. One arm is in bad shape and needs to be repaired if we wish to display it. We need to see if we could get anyone to repair it.

Christmas Masses were discussed. It is predicted that we would have double the current attendance at these masses.

We will not be doing a candle for each of the deceased during the Service of Remembrance or have family members come up. The family members present will stand as the name is called and then sit down. We need greeters in the narthex and two people in church to seat people.
