Meeting was called to order at 7:10 pm

Welcome/Opening Prayer - Led by Tom Kalinosky.

Approve January Minutes

Marge moved; Greg seconded - approved minutes by voice vote.

Reports: Committee Liaisons/Council Goals:

- Mass Welcoming Report *12 people can make a difference*: Four members reported their stories.
- **Finance Council**: Chris - School date for July meeting (typical 3rd Tuesday of month)
- **Liturgy Committee**: Dan – discussed the renovation. Need “all hands on deck” and lots of people for the dedication. Council members volunteered to be there and help.
- **Faith Formation Committee**: Discussed times for the activities during adoration. Tom presented information on Men Of Christ Confirmation conference in Milwaukee. The movie UNPLANNED will be presented at the Rec also on the 15th at 3pm (free will offering). Twenty-five percent of the money collected from Rice Bowl will be given to PAVE.
- **Human Concerns Committee**: Discussed upcoming Adoration times and events.
- **Food For Souls Committee**: Most of the salsa has been delivered (two months ago). Remaining jars of sauce will be passed out to SKD church ‘neighbors’ for the SKD Renovation Open House.
- **HISPANIC Committee**: Hispanic leaders have been introduced to the staff. Father Erick is working with the Hispanic SKD community. Father Erick presented a wonderful presentation of how each element of the SKD mission and vision is directly related in the Hispanic community. He will be sharing this at the next staff meeting and will be translating the slides into English.
- **Stewardship Committee**: Father Mike explained that in the past year the formal Stewardship Committee transformed into the BFOB (Building From Our Belief) fundraising group with Walsh & Associates. Some of the basic functions were performed by our staff such as reporting and survey for Time and Talent. Bob presented both the Arch and SKD PPC appendix requirements for the formal committee. It was decided that the Stewardship Committee will be restarted at the end of the renovation and beginning of our new year this summer.
- Be sure to review emailed committee minutes reports before the PPC meeting. Bob reported that the Website is not getting these reports published. It is also important to parishioners.
- Discussion about adding a youth member to the Council and a Committee. General agreement.

Pastoral Council Handbooks – None were requested

Discernment of new council members – We will formally open the membership discernment at our April meeting with a bulletin invitation to our parishioners. In May, will be the invites to parishioners. All three members who finished their first three year term agreed to a second term. Bob offered that if

someone from the parish would volunteer to become a new Council member that he would then step down.

Building From Our Belief. Occupancy is projected to be for March 20, 2020 (time will be used for cleaning and moving into the church). Dedication is still planned for April 3, 2020. The Grand Opening date is yet to be determined but probably late May after the parking lot is paved. Holy week will be held in our newly renovated church.

Budget: General discussion. Consensus is that overall it is looking good.

Good of the Group: Marge reported that fish fries are this Friday at Horicon Sacred Heart (4-7) and Waupun (5-7). Also fries will be coming soon at St Columbkille March 20 and Holy Family March 27.
