### **Decisions Made:**

**Much discussion on where to place statues, icons, etc. was had by the committee. No firm decisions were made but the following were suggestions made by the committee:**

- **The wooden statue of Mary—possibly place statue in the old bookstore (this room will be used by Secular Franciscans, Knights of Columbus, etc). If this statue does not fit in the bookstore, should it be sold?**
- **Coletta suggested that the Narthex Nook area could be used for a place to put various statues on a rotational basis (feastdays, etc.)**
- **Suggestion was made to sell by consignment the St. Teresa statue.**
- **Other icons (including Mary, Mother of the church and Hugh Kirsh painting of the Nativity window) will be kept for future use in the narthex.**
- **Suggestion was made to possibly put the Stations of the Cross made by Jerry Kamps in Mission Hall.**
- **Dan stated that every room should have a Crucifix and quotes of St. Katharine Drexel (“The Eucharist is a never ending sacrifice. It is a sacrament of love.” “A missionary is one who is sent with the power of Christ. You are sent.”  
The quotes from St. Katharine could be possibly projected or painted but should include her signature.**
- **Tanya will send a dropbox link and would like all of us to view the video of the assessment tool and then brainstorm for the next meeting.**
- **Discussion on fogging and washing pews after Masses on the weekend for sanitation. Fogging should be done after the 4:30 Mass and 8:00 Mass and washing the pews after the 10:00 Mass.**
- **The Service of Remembrance will be on November 1 at 6pm. The scroll will still be done; it is difficult to predict how many will attend the service. Tanya is checking with the funeral homes to see if we can use the photos which are used in the obituaries.**
- **The cornerstone dedication will be on September 29 at 9:00 am.**
