- 1. Parking Lot lights-to be repaired and LED lights installed late August.
- 2. Cement Work-PCC flag pole secured; Brian getting a couple bids for PCC sidewalk panels and St. Gen Parish Office and church. Est cost. \$14,000; possibly done in September; Brian will email bids to group for review.
- 3. Parking Lot repair/sealcoating-Hugo to be done Aug. 14; Centerville in early September.
- 4. Doors-est. cost \$2500; waiting for bid on paper.
- 5. Trees StG and Parish Office- Dean's Landscaping will take care of dead trees this fall.

III. New Business:

- 1. PCC Roof-there is a soft section in north roof. John got an estimate to fix under \$500. Recommended to get it patched with the recommendation of getting bids to reshingle.
- 2. Parish Office boiler-leaking. Recommended to fix valves and get a quote for a less efficient (cheaper) boiler in case fixing the old valves and pipes leads to more issues requiring a replacement.
- 3. Water Heaters-recommended to wait until Parish Office water heater (1992 installed) leaks, then replace.
- 4. Cemetery fence-Tom Wilharber had told Susie that the City of Centerville would like us to consider putting in a more attractive fence along Main Street. They have a grant in which we could apply. Waiting for more information.
