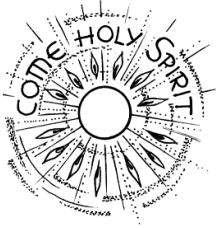


Confirmation Package

Each candidate is asked to compose a letter at the end of the Confirmation preparation journey to state their intent of wanting to be confirmed in the Catholic Church. Within the letter, Confirmation candidates should write what it is they have done to prepare for the sacrament, why they want to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, and what it is they are planning to do once they're confirmed to continue to grow in their faith.

For this year, candidates are asked to reflect and answer these questions as a letter of intent to Fr. Greg.

Tell me about you:

What are your reasons for wanting to be confirmed?

What are your spiritual habits regarding daily prayer, Sunday Mass, and care for the poor?

Who have you chosen as your sponsor and why?

What are your plans to continue to grow in your faithful following of Christ after you are confirmed?

What is the strongest statement you can make about your commitment to Jesus Christ?

What ministry or volunteer position in our parish have you chosen to keep you growing in your faith? (i.e. altar server, greeters/usher, vbs, catechist assistant, etc.)
