Dinner Hosts 5:00-8:00 pm Assist staff with serving dinner, eat & socialize w/ families, clean up. No cooking required!

Overnight Hosts 8:00 pm-7:00 am Sleep at the shelter, pack lunches for guests, start the morning routine. ***If you are retired or don't need to leave early**, the overnight host can sign up for **both** the Overnight and Early Morning shifts and stay until 9am*

Early Morning Relief Hosts 7:00am-9:00am

Set out breakfast, clean up & lock up so overnight host can get to work.

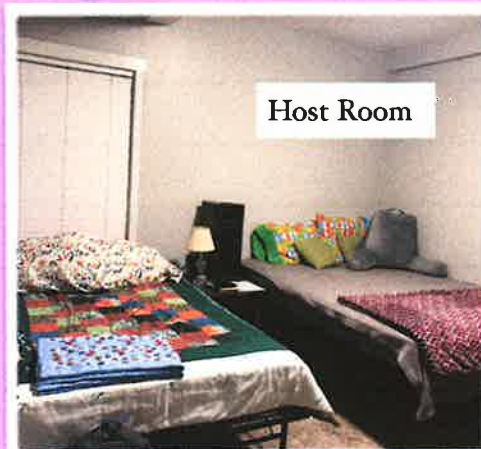
Provide Dinner: Cook a meal and drop it off ready to serve.

Overnight Hosts Needed

The Overnight host spots are the hardest to fill but really you just lock the doors and go to bed. You are on hand in case of an emergency but mainly your job is to sleep. Will you consider a night away from your own bed to help families in shelter sleep better?

Quick Facts

- * Up to 5 families can stay at the shelter
- * 12 churches supply volunteers
- * 90% of families that complete the program exit with stable housing
- * \$8,200 -monthly cost for St. Andrew's to operate the shelter.
