The Widow's Penny: Lessons from the Tootsie Roll Drive

St. Patrick's and St. Casimir's members were again extremely generous during the Knights of Columbus tootsie roll drive during the weekend of April 25th and 26th.

The Knights of Columbus will distribute these funds directly to the Valley Friendship Club in Stillwater, MN, Special Olympics MN, and other 501 C3 Disability organizations.

The Saturday Mass contributed \$142 and Sunday \$267.01, for a total donation of \$409.01.

The \$0.01 is significant in that the person who gave the \$0.01 was a lady who lives in the housing complex at St. Casimir's. We offered her a tootsie roll as she walked by on the sidewalk in front of church at the time mass was letting out, not knowing anything about her. She commented that she has nothing to give. We let her know that the tootsie rolls were not for sale and that a donation was not necessary. She smiled and said thank you as she accepted the tootsie roll. She took a couple steps and then turned back and took out a penny from her slightly tattered coat pocket. She said that she has one penny to give and said it is yours and let us know that she lives right here next to the church. She had a nice smile on her face and a bounce in her step as she walked to the housing complex. That was an extremely satisfying donation.

That reminded me of Luke 21:3-4: "Truly I tell you" Jesus said, "this poor widow has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on."

The members of St. Patrick's and St. Casimir's have been extremely generous, as my brother and I have witnessed over the probably 30+ years we have been helping with the tootsie roll drive. They consistently give what should be considered a surprising amount, given both the number of people and the perceived neighborhood financial environment. However, I have come to know that the contributions are not surprising. The members of St. Patrick's and St. Casimir's are consistently generous with their time, talents, and financial contributions. I believe they are consistently giving deeper than their wealth. They give from their hearts. I am very proud of this community.
