June: Month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

June is the month the Church dedicates to the Sacred Heart of Jesus – a devotion that invites us to contemplate the immeasurable love of God made visible in the Heart of His Son.

When we speak of the Sacred Heart, we are really speaking about love – the love that led God to become one of us, to walk among us, to suffer and die for us. The Heart of Jesus is the sign of that love: real, personal, and tireless. It is a love that does not keep score, that does not give up, and that is offered to each of us no matter where we have been or what we have done.

In the 17th century, Our Lord appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, revealing His Heart aflame with love yet wounded by indifference, and asking for reparation and consecration in return. The Church celebrates this gift each year on the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart, observed on the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost.

We can honor the Sacred Heart in many simple ways: by attending Mass with greater attention and gratitude, by keeping the practice of the First Friday devotion, by praying the Litany of the Sacred Heart, or simply by pausing each day to offer our hearts back to the One who loves us without measure.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place my trust in You.
