God Bless You on Your New Mission, Father Mateusz!

I've been saying some goodbyes recently, but as someone said, it's not "goodbye," it's "see you later." I would like to express my gratitude to everyone from our parish communities. It has been a blessing to serve here in my first year as a priest! When our Oblate provincial assigned me here last year, he told me that it is common to send new priests to a shorter first assignment before giving them a longer assignment. So, he told me that I would likely be at St. Casimir and St. Patrick for about a year. I was hoping he would forget so that I could stay here longer, but he kept his word! And that's the end of my cross-country skiing career (at least for now).

I have now been assigned to Our Lady of Refuge Parish in Eagle Pass, Texas, which is an English- and Spanish-speaking community. The Oblates of Mary Immaculate in Eagle Pass serve three parishes, so we will be a local community of four Oblates.

Historically, Oblates have been serving along the border (the Rio Grande) since 1849. Back then, they were French missionaries, and they traveled from place to place on horseback! While I will not have a horse, I will be honored to be part of this history of service to the communities there.



I would like to say that as an Oblate, it is a blessing to experience different communities, including here in Saint Paul. What I see is that we are all connected first of all as a family in faith, called together by our Lord, Jesus Christ, who has made us all brothers and sisters. There is shared history here as well - the Oblates have been at St. Casimir for more than a century. While the Oblates have come to serve at St. Patrick in more recent times, I would like to point out that French and Italian Oblates first traveled to Laos in 1935, and they began to

evangelize the Hmong communities in Laos in the 1950s. Even here, you see that we are connected to a wider family that spans across the globe and across generations.
