Welcome, Deacon Mateusz Garstecki, O.M.I., into our Community!



Greetings! My name is Deacon Mateusz Garstecki, OMI. I am originally from the Chicago area but grew up in San Antonio, Texas. I have an older sister and two younger brothers. Growing up, faith was important in the life of our family. We would go to Mass every Sunday and we would pray the Rosary at home. When I was in high school, after I was confirmed, I became involved in my home parish as an extraordinary minister of Communion. I also came to love reading the Scriptures. I felt called to live my faith and to serve God and others, but I was not sure how. Towards the end of high school, I was praying to the Lord for guidance for my future. I met a Sister of the Sacred Heart of Jesus who helped me come to know the Oblates of Mary

Immaculate. I was impressed by their work as missionaries and their commitment to service of the poor and most abandoned, and I felt the Lord calling me to join them. So, I began my formation after completing high school, in 2016.

Since then, my formation has taken me to many places. I joined the Oblate Pre-Novitiate in Buffalo, NY, where I studied philosophy for three years. Then, my companions and I spent a year in the Novitiate in Godfrey, IL. At the end of the year, we professed our first religious vows as Oblates. I began my theology

studies in San Antonio, TX, after which I was invited to continue studying in Rome. So, I had a great opportunity to be part of an international formation community in Rome for three years, at the end of which I made my perpetual profession of vows with six other brothers. After that, I came back to the United States, and I was ordained a deacon last year in October. I spent this past year serving in two parishes in Caseyville and Fairmont City, IL. Presently, I am preparing for priestly ordination, which will be on September 13th, 2025, at my home parish in San Antonio, TX!

I am happy to come to St. Casimir and St. Patrick and I look forward to getting to know everyone. Please keep me in prayer, and I will also keep you in prayer!
