Father's Notes

People of God

I don't remember the name of the song but it has a verse in it that basically says, "Holiness is what I long for." In the past I always thought that phrase really reflected my inner desire. Although this still applies I believe it also refers to God's desire for us. The second chapter of Lumen gentium talks about God's People. God has been calling people to himself since the beginning of time. He has called a specific people to have a special relationship with him that they might, "acknowledge him and serve him in holiness" (9). God wants us to be holy. One way to define being holy is being set apart by God for a specific purpose. Our purpose is to live for the salvation of the world.

We are not the first people God set apart. That would be the people of Israel. They were called by God to offer sacrifice, to serve those in need and govern those under their care. Through the prophets God tells the people Israel that he longed for them to be holy and obedient to his will freely. When Christ instituted the new covenant in his blood on the cross he fulfilled the prophecy. St. Peter tells us in his first letter that from the cross Jesus made the Church and her members, "a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession...who in times past were not a people, but now are the people of God" (1 Peter 2:9-10). The people of God no longer have to come from the tribe of Israel but can come from every nation, culture, family and individual that wants to freely follow him. That's pretty exciting! Stay tuned next week for how God calls us members of the Church to live in holiness.

Notas del Padre

Pueblo de Dios

No recuerdo el nombre de una canción, pero tiene un verso en ella que básicamente dice: "Santidad es lo que anhelo". En el pasado siempre pensé que esa frase realmente reflejaba mi deseo interior. Aunque esto todavía se aplica, creo que también se refiere al deseo de Dios por nosotros. El segundo capítulo de Lumen gentium habla del Pueblo de Dios. Dios ha estado llamando a la gente para sí mismo desde el principio de los tiempos. Él ha llamado a su pueblo específicamente a tener una relación especial con él para que ellos puedan "reconocerlo y servirle en santidad" (9). Dios nos quiere santos. Una manera de definir la santidad es ser una nación consagrada a Dios para un propósito específico. Nuestro propósito en la vida es la salvación del mundo.

No somos el primer pueblo que Dios consagra. Ese sería el pueblo de Israel. Fueron llamados por Dios para ofrecer sacrificios, para servir a los necesitados y para gobernar a los que estaban bajo su cuidado. Por medio de los profetas, Dios le dice al pueblo de Israel que anhelaba que fueran santos y obedientes a su voluntad. Cuando Cristo instituyó la nueva alianza de su sangre en la cruz, él cumplió la profecía. San Pedro nos dice en su primera carta que desde la cruz Jesús hizo a la Iglesia ya sus miembros "una raza consagrada, un sacerdocio real, una nación santa, un pueblo para su propia posesión ... que en tiempos pasados no eran un pueblo, Pero ahora son el pueblo de Dios" (1 Pedro 2:9-10). El pueblo de Dios ya no tiene que venir de la tribu de Israel, sino que puede venir de todas las naciones, culturas, familias e individuos que quieren seguirlo libremente. Eso es muy emocionante! Estén atentos la próxima semana para saber cómo Dios nos llama miembros de la Iglesia para vivir en santidad.

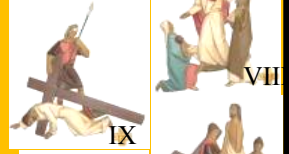

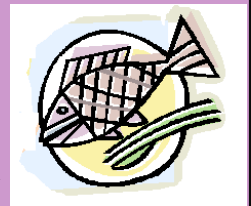

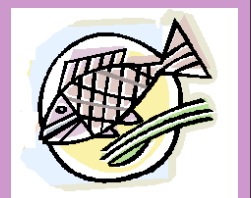
Lenten Abstinence and Fasting Regulations

Just as a reminder, during Lent we are called to abstain from meat on Fridays as a reminder that our Lord offered His body — a flesh sacrifice — for our sins. We also abstain from meat and fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Here the fast entails having only one full meal a day which is sufficient to maintain one's strength. Two other meatless meals are allowed, but are to be light and penitential. Everyone 14 years of age and older is bound to the law of abstinence, and everyone 18 years of age but not yet 60 is bound to the law of fasting. Of course, one must be mindful of his own physical condition. These physical sacrifices help each of us to be spiritually mindful that Our Lord suffered and died for our sins.



Reglamentos Sobre el Ayuno y la Abstinencia

Todos los católicos de 14 años y mayores deben abstenerse de comer carne los viernes de Cuaresma, Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Todos los católicos entre las edades de 18 y 59 deben ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Ayunar significa comer una comida completa, las otras dos comidas de ese día deben ser inferior a la cantidad normal, a menos que ya se encuentran en un mínimo para una buena salud. Comer entre comidas no está permitido, sin embargo, los líquidos como el café, la leche y los zumos de frutas están permitidos. El Miércoles, 6 de marzo es un día de Ember de la Arquidiócesis. Tradicionalmente, los días de temperas son días de oración y ayuno. La intención de este Día Ember es para la formación de la fe efectiva de los niños y adultos. Pero no es Obligatorio.
