PARKING ZONE

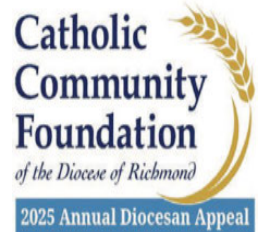
Attention:

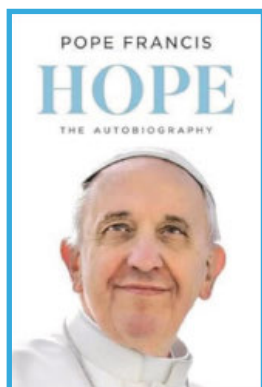
**R&R Wednesday (Reflection

Book Discussion Group: *Hope by Pope Francis* Sat. Oct. 18, 10 a.m. - Noon

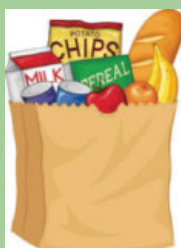
