10 am - Noon

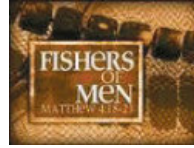

and Recreation) begins Wed., Sept.

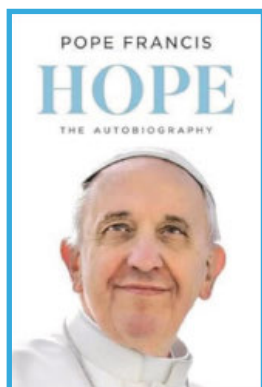

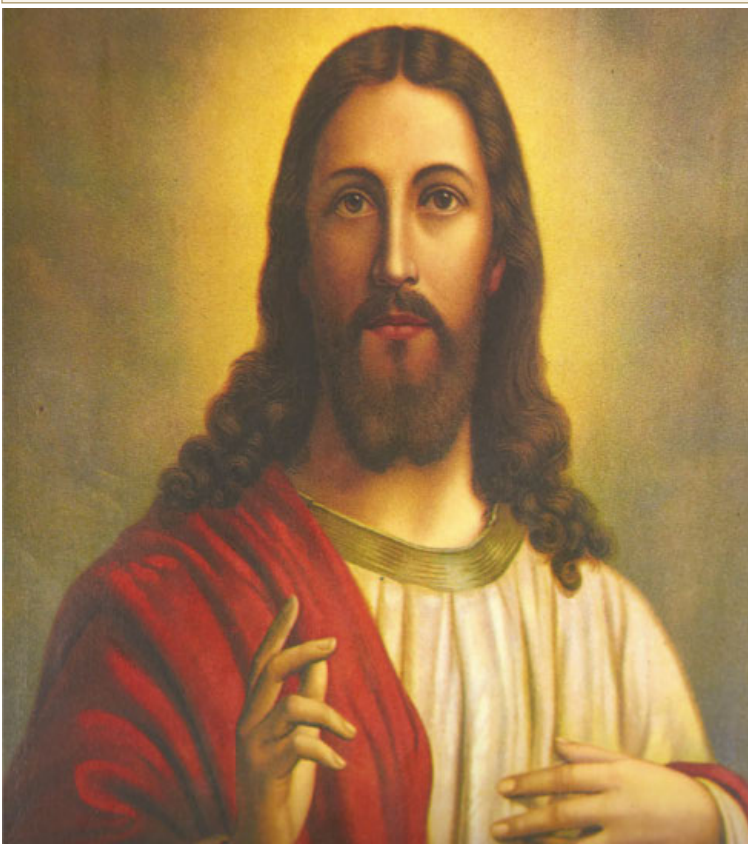
