Holy Land Emergency Appeal

As the war in Israel continues, there is a heavy toll on innocent people in the region. Mounting violence and threats are intensifying each day. Our hearts and minds are attuned to children and families victimized by terrorism in the Middle East.

The Diocese of Richmond has a long history of generosity in times such as these.

Bishop Knestout has been in contact with the Catholic Near East Welfare Association (CNEWA) and Pontifical mission. CNEWA is on the ground in the key regions of Jerusalem, Gaza, Beirut, and Amman. Their goal is to support high-priority, immediate emergency needs as well as long-term emergency needs. To this end, they have launched a Holy Land Emergency Appeal aimed at helping those most in need.

The Bishop is asking that all parishes in the diocese participate in this appeal. **We will have a second collection this weekend. If you are an e-giver or would like to do an electronic donation, please our website.** The link is on the front page.

Your participation is greatly appreciated. Please continue to pray for an end to this conflict, let us be intentional and dedicated in our prayers; working for peace in our own lives; in our communities; and through out the world.

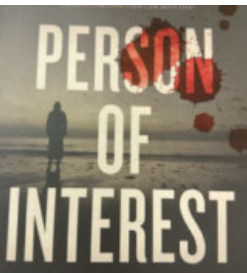
Food Pantry Weekend, Jan. 6 & 7


