Parish Update

October is going to be a busy month for those who know that abortion is against God's Will, and for those Catholics who are Pro-Life (which all Catholics should be!).

The "**40 Days of Life**" sidewalk rosaries that are being prayed daily throughout October continue, having begun in September. These rosaries are located close to the PP abortion clinic here in Escondido.

On October 16th, the **Annual Escondido Rosary Rally** will be held at the Escondido Centre of the Arts parking lot to raise awareness of Pro-Life and Public Prayer.

And, on October 24, the **Annual Life Walk**, co-sponsored by St. Mary and St. Timothy Parishes, will originate from the St. Timothy Parish Hall.

Get your rosaries and walking shoes, and join in praying for the end to abortion!

The Barriers that Separate Us

We live in a society that has many technological avenues for stimulation and entertainment, one in which the urban population exceeds the non-urban. It is curious that loneliness is a prevalent malady. It is easy to reach out and touch someone, we are told. But—in truth—it is not all that easy, and statistics from the mental health field will reinforce that opinion. Today's readings are about the ways in which we can authentically reach out: God touches Adam to create a mate and end his solitude; God-in-Jesus takes on human flesh and death in order that we might come to glory; Jesus reaches out to the children whom the disciples had tried to keep away, showing us the manner in which we must approach the loving embrace that awaits us in heaven. Until that day, however, we must remember that ours is a sacramental church, a church of signs of the love of God. And so we are called to reach out continually to ease the loneliness and the barriers that separate us from one another and, therefore, from the love of Christ.

Es curioso que la soledad sea un mal prevalente. Es fácil de alcanzar y tocar a alguien, se nos dice. Pero, en verdad, no es tan fácil, y las estadísticas de salud mental refuerzan esa opinión. Las lecturas de hoy son las formas en las que auténticamente podemos acercarnos a otros: Dios toca a Adán para crearle una compañera y poner fin a su soledad, Dios en Jesús asume forma humana y la muerte con el fin de que podamos llegar a la gloria; Jesús se acerca a los niños que los discípulos habían tratado de alejar, mostrándonos así cómo aceptar el abrazo amoroso que nos espera en el cielo. Hasta ese día, sin embargo, debemos recordar que la nuestra es una Iglesia sacramental, una Iglesia de signos del amor de Dios. Y así estamos llamados a acercarnos a otros continuamente para aliviar la soledad y derribar las barreras que nos separan unos de otros y, por tanto, del amor de Cristo.

Janet was blessed to be born into a Catholic family. She was raised in New Jersey and attended Catholic elementary and high schools. In 1978, she married a US Marine, Bob Troy, and the couple moved to San Diego.

For the first 22 years of their marriage, Janet and Bob were blessed in many ways including the birth of their son and daughter. They built a home in Poway and were involved in school and sports activities with their children. They also became parishioners at St. Gabriel Church and participated in numerous parish activities.

In December 2000, Bob and Janet's world was turned upside down when Bob was diagnosed with terminal brain cancer. Bob was given 10 months to 2 years to live. The couple relied on the power of prayer to deal with this tragedy; as a result, a miracle healing occurred. Along with that healing came Bob's spiritual conversion and a calling to become a Deacon. Bob served as the spiritual advisor for Magnificat for several years.

Sixteen years after Bob and Janet had been told that Bob had no more than 2 years to live, our kind and generous Lord called him home.

Come and witness Janet's powerful testimony to prayer, hope, faith and love which helped shaped the lives of Janet and Bob and how God continues to provide a silver lining to every dark cloud.

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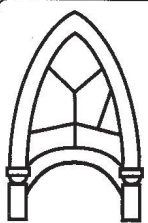
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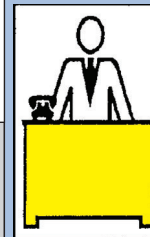
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
