Month of the Passion

The month of February is traditionally dedicated to the Passion of Our Lord in anticipation of the liturgical season of Lent. In this month, we begin to meditate on the mystery of Jesus' sufferings which culminated in his death on the Cross for the redemption of mankind. Saints who had a special devotion to Christ's passion include St. Francis of Assisi, who was the first known saint to receive the stigmata; St. John of the Cross; St. Bridget of Sweden; and St. Catherine of Siena.

Our Religious Education Program prepares a person for complete initiation into the Catholic Church and an enriching and active life in the Church. It encompasses the preparation of those who have been baptized to receive their First Communion and Confirmation, and for adults, it prepares them for full initiation into the Catholic Church through the RCIA program.

The next registration period will begin in February 2022 for the cycle 2022-2023. Children are accepted from the first grade of school for First Communion, and 13-year-olds can apply for Confirmation. All sacraments require at least two years of preparation. Parents are required to attend formation classes. With the help of the Holy Spirit, we all cooperate in the Catholic Christian formation of our youth. Thank you for allowing us to share this faith journey with you and your child.

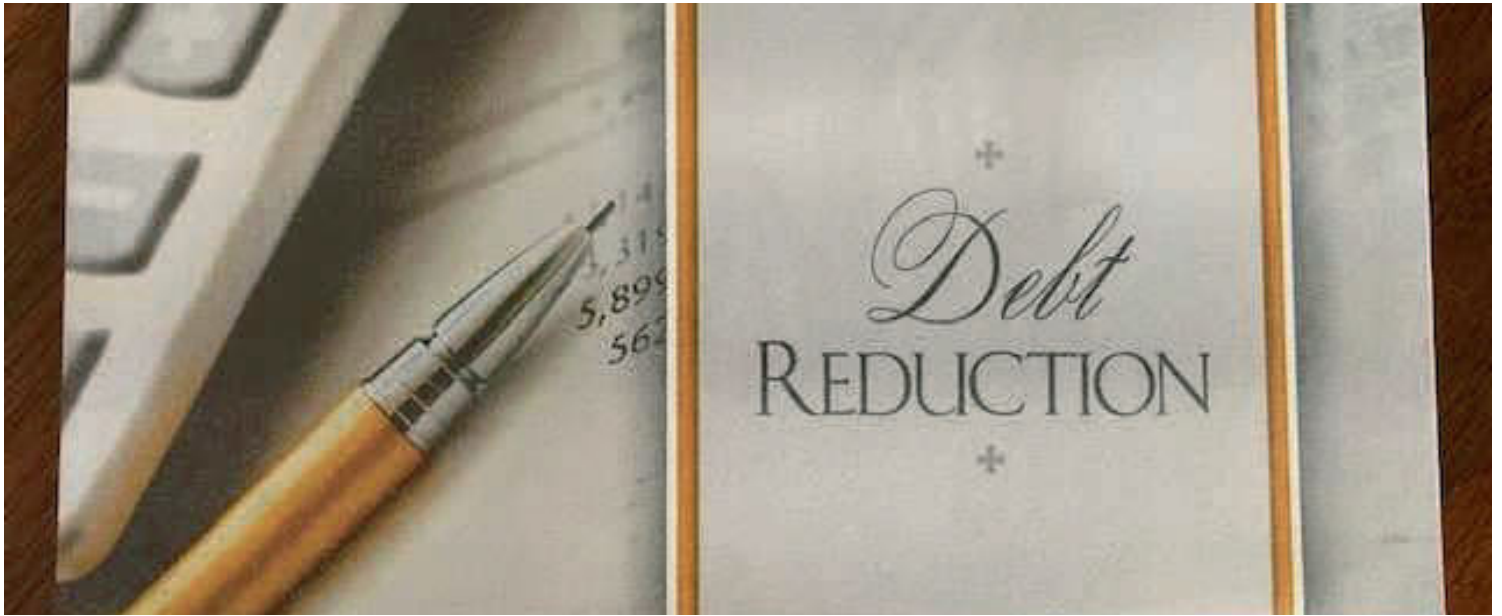


RECIPES, RECIPES, RECIPES!!!

DEBT REDUCTION

As of February 1, the remaining principal balance on the Parish Center building loan was \$1,849,340. The February 1 monthly payment was made in the amount of \$10,587 -- \$2,881 was applied to the principal and \$7,706 was interest expense. Although the three-year Capital Campaign has concluded, we thank those parishioners who continue their generous donations to cover the monthly loan payments. The Debt Reduction donations are deposited to a separate bank account. Donations in excess of the monthly payments are in reserve for future payment on the principal balance. We hope to refinance for more favorable terms when the current loan terms allow.

In February the SECOND COLLECTION for Debt Reduction will be the third weekend February 19 and 20. We have this special collection once a month, but donations are encouraged at any time. Please use the new numbered GRAY Debt Reduction envelopes or the Debt Reduction envelopes that can be found in the church. Online donations are encouraged and can be scheduled for your convenience on our website www.stmaryp.org. Please designate the online Debt Reduction donations as "Parish Center".
