REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

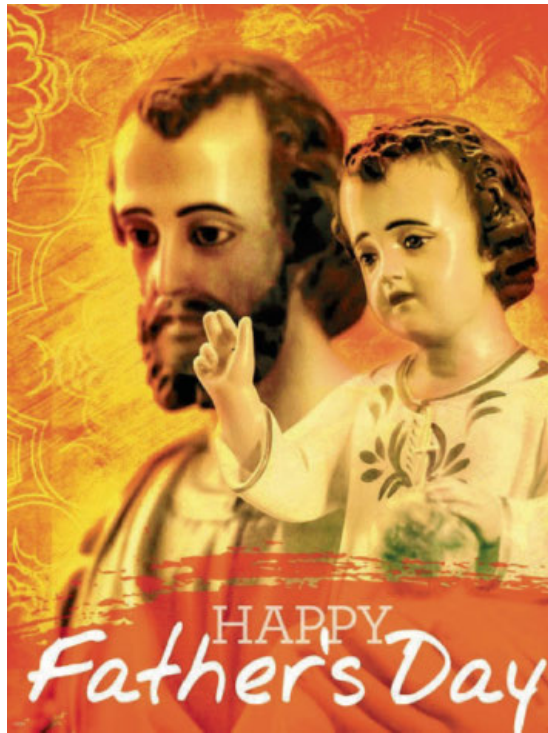

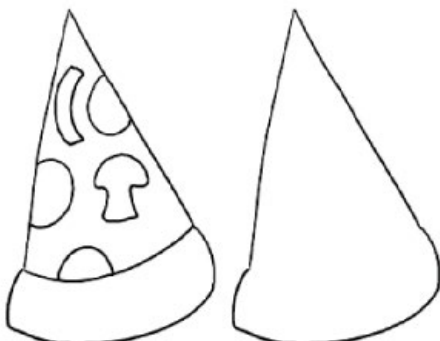

CULTURE OF LIFE – FATHERS: CALLED TO WELCOME AND PROTECT LIFE!

"Fatherhood has its origins in God, who chose to reveal Himself to us as Our Father, sending his only Son for the sake of our salvation. Fathers therefore have a special role "in revealing and in reliving on earth the very fatherhood of God" (*Familiaris consortio* 25). Indeed, the role of the father "is of unique and irreplaceable importance" (FC 25).

...Pope Saint John Paul II said fathers are called to exhibit "generous responsibility for the life conceived under the heart of the mother" (FC 25). They are uniquely entrusted with the protection and defense of both mother and child and, in this way, in safeguarding the sanctity of human life. Yet research continues to show that the top reasons women seek abortions include lacking support from the child's father and financial challenges, which are only exacerbated by a father's absence.

As a Church community, we need to encourage and support men to follow the example of St. Joseph and embrace their various roles as father. But, despite all obstacles, Joseph was faithful. He welcomed life, offering care and protection to Mary and Jesus. We pray that each expectant father will find courage in the example of St. Joseph and offer loving, life-affirming support to the mother of his child."

La paternidad tiene sus orígenes en Dios, que decidió revelarse ante nosotros como Padre Dios enviando a su único Hijo para salvarnos. Por lo tanto, los padres tienen una función exclusiva y especial "revelando y reviviendo en la tierra la misma paternidad de Dios" (*Familiaris consortio* 25)

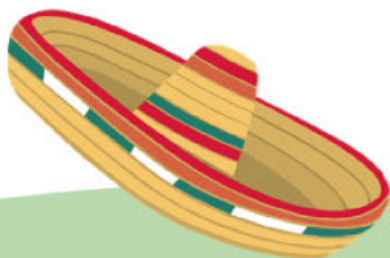

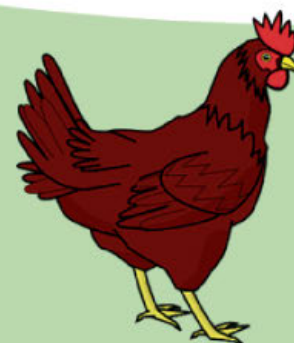

MEET OUR DEACONS

MEET DEACON (DCN.) JIM AND CAROL KOSTICK

As a young boy, Dcn. Jim was raised in a Catholic family in Minneapolis, Minnesota, and attended 12 years of Catholic school. In his youth, he served God as an altar boy for 8 years, and saw his faith in God start to grow. Little did he know when he began his faith journey what the Lord had in store for him!

Dcn. Jim met his soulmate, Carol, at the age of 15. Carol also came from a strong Catholic family. They married when they were both 18, and together, raised seven children (6 girls and 1 boy). Their family continues to grow so that now there are 21 grandchildren, and 16 great-grandchildren. In 1971, the Kostick family moved to Escondido and began a new life. They joined Resurrection Parish and attended there for 40 years. Dcn. and Carol both served in a variety of lay ministries in that parish.

In 1975, due to an illness, the couple started to attend Charismatic prayer meetings at St. Frances Parish in Vista, seeking healing and a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ. In 1976, they attended a "Life in the Spirit" seminar, and through that experience, received their Baptism in the Holy Spirit. The power of the Holy Spirit changed Dcn. Jim and Carol's lives. Together, they committed their lives to making Jesus their Lord with the Scripture **"For I know well the plans I have in mind for you" says the Lord, 'plans for your welfare and not for woe, so as to give you a future full of hope.'**" (Jer. 29:11) as the focus of their lives.

The call to the Diaconate came from the Holy Spirit on an airplane while returning home after a funeral of their uncle who was a priest in Minnesota. Dcn. Jim experienced God's voice, calling him to take his uncle's place, and was obedient by applying to become a Deacon. He was ordained in May 1985 at St. Patrick's Parish in Carlsbad.

Dcn. Jim was assigned to Resurrection Parish, performing normal deacon duties and for 15 years in prison ministry. He also served at Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish in Ramona as a part-time administrator.

Dcn. Jim and Carol have now been at St. Mary Parish for 17 years, serving the needy under Fr. Rich, and now under Fr. Scott. Dcn. Jim's favorite ministries are Baptisms, Healing Prayer services, and preaching. On May 25, 2022, Dcn. celebrated the 37th anniversary of his ordination with some of their family attending. Dcn. Jim and Carol have been truly blessed!



CONOCE A DEACON (DCN.) JIM Y CAROL KOSTICK

Cuando era niño, Dcn. Jim se crió en una familia católica en Minneapolis, Minnesota, y asistió a una escuela católica durante 12 años. En su juventud, sirvió a Dios como monaguillo durante 8 años y vio crecer su fe en Dios. ¡Poco sabía cuando comenzó

su viaje de fe lo que el Señor tenía reservado para él!

Dcn. Jim conoció a su alma gemela, Carol, a la edad de 15 años. Carol también provenía de una sólida familia católica. Se casaron cuando ambos tenían 18 años y juntos criaron siete hijos (6 niñas y 1 niño). Su familia sigue creciendo y ahora hay 21 nietos y 16 bisnietos.

En 1971, los Kostick se mudaron a Escondido y comenzaron una nueva vida. Se unieron a Resurrection Parish y asistieron allí durante 40 años.

Dcn. y Carol sirvieron en una variedad de ministerios laicos en esa parroquia.

En 1975, debido a una enfermedad, la pareja comenzó a asistir a reuniones de oración carismática en la parroquia de St. Frances en Vista, en busca de sanación y una relación más profunda con Jesucristo.

En 1976, asistieron a un seminario de "Vida en el Espíritu", ya través de esa experiencia, recibieron su Bautismo en el Espíritu Santo. El poder del Espíritu Santo cambió Dcn. La vida de Jim y Carol. Juntos comprometieron sus vidas para hacer de Jesús su Señor con la Escritura **"Porque yo sé bien los planes**

que tengo para vosotros -dice el Señor-, planes de bienestar y no de aflicción, para daros un futuro pleno. de esperanza." (Jeremías 29:11) como el centro de sus vidas.

El llamado al diaconado vino del Espíritu Santo en un avión mientras regresaban a casa después de un funeral de su tío que era sacerdote en Minnesota. Dcn. Jim experimentó la voz de Dios, llamándolo a tomar el lugar de su tío, y fue obediente al solicitar convertirse en diácono. Fue ordenado en mayo de 1985 en la parroquia de St. Patrick en Carlsbad.

Dcn. Jim fue asignado a la Parroquia de la Resurrección, realizando deberes normales de diácono y durante 15 años en el ministerio de prisiones. También sirvió en la parroquia Immaculate Heart of Mary en Ramona como administrador a tiempo parcial.

Dcn. Jim y Carol ahora han estado en la Parroquia de St. Mary por 17 años, sirviendo a los necesitados bajo la dirección del Padre. Rich, y ahora bajo el p. scott Dcn. Los ministerios favoritos de Jim son los bautismos, los servicios de oración de sanación y la predicación.
