

GOSPEL REFLECTION

The parables are true chairs of Jesus, His teachings never go out of fashion. Today we listen with joy to three of the seven parables that Matthew offers us in chapter 13. The one with the weeds, the mustard seed and the yeast. To show the Kingdom of heaven, Jesus compares the wheat and the weeds, the mustard seed and the yeast that ferments the dough. Last Sunday was about the sower, who sows his seed along the road. We'll be hearing more parables next Sunday. What does the Word of God mean to us with His parables? It is simply to stop doing evil and dedicate ourselves to doing good. All that matters is the Kingdom of God. To be wheat, to be a grain of mustard seed and to be yeast, is to unite ourselves to Jesus in order to improve the society in which we live.

REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO


Las parábolas son verdaderas cátedras de Jesús, nunca pasan de moda sus enseñanzas. Hoy escuchamos con alegría tres de las siete parábolas que Mateo nos ofrece en el capítulo 13. La de la cizaña, la semilla de mostaza y la levadura. Para mostrar el Reino de los cielos, Jesús compara el trigo y la cizaña, la semilla de mostaza y la levadura que fermenta la masa. El domingo pasado fue la del sembrador, que siembra su semilla a lo largo del camino. El domingo que viene escucharemos otras de ellas. ¿Qué nos quiere decir la Palabra de Dios con sus parábolas? Sencillamente, es dejar de hacer el mal y dedicarnos a hacer el bien. A rendidas cuentas lo que importa es el Reino de Dios. Ser trigo, ser un granito de mostaza y ser levadura, es unirnos al equipo de Jesús para mejorar la sociedad en que vivimos.

LITURGICAL FOCUS

The Precious Blood

The month of July traditionally honors the Most Precious Blood of Jesus. It is the blood of Christ, the Lamb of God, which cleanses us from sin—therefore the Church developed a devotion to Jesus' physical blood and its mystical power, just as it did for His Sacred Heart from which His blood poured out on the Cross. The Precious Blood of Jesus courses through the Church spiritually, giving eternal life to the Body of Christ through the sacraments. Devotion to the Precious Blood spread widely through the preaching of Saint Gaspar del Bufalo, who was a 19th-century priest and the founder of the Missionaries of the Precious Blood. This devotion was later approved and recommended by the Holy See. The feast day of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus is July 1st. **Properly honoring the Precious Blood requires recognizing sin and repentance to obtain a life of grace and union with God.**



ENFOQUE LITÚRGICO

La Preciosísima Sangre

El mes de Julio tradicionalmente honra la Preciosísima Sangre de Jesús. Es la sangre de Cristo, el Cordero de Dios, la que nos limpia del pecado; por lo tanto, la Iglesia desarrolló una devoción a la sangre física de Jesús y su poder místico, tal como lo hizo por Su Sagrado Corazón, del cual Su sangre se derramó en la Cruz. La Preciosa Sangre de Jesús fluye a través de la Iglesia espiritualmente, dando vida eterna al Cuerpo de Cristo a través de los sacramentos. La devoción a la Preciosa Sangre se extendió ampliamente a través de la predicación de San Gaspar del Búfalo, sacerdote del siglo XIX y fundador de los Misioneros de la Preciosísima Sangre. Esta devoción fue posteriormente aprobada y recomendada por la Santa Sede. El día de la fiesta de la Preciosísima Sangre de Jesús es el 1 de julio. **Honrar adecuadamente la Preciosa Sangre requiere reconocer el pecado y el arrepentimiento para obtener una vida de gracia y unión con Dios.**
