## GOSPEL REFLECTION

The Palm Sunday procession serves as the entrance to Holy Week. Jesus carries out his last activity before His arrest on Holy Thursday. He enters Jerusalem triumphantly and the joy is not long in coming, adults and children receive Him, applaud Him and praise Him singing. Today we begin our celebration with a bouquet of palms in our hands and sing the same praise of hosanna. The Paschal mystery begins and we must participate, not as actors, but as true disciples of the Lord. In these holy days, we have the opportunity to amend many situations that hinder us from helping others. We have the opportunity to approach the sick as a family to share the message of mercy and compassion that Jesus shows us in this very special time. They should be days of purification of our faith and focusing on the liturgical events that the Church proposes to us for true spiritual growth. Will we accompany Jesus or leave Him alone in His Easter Triduum?

## REFLEXIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Tenemos la oportunidad de acercarnos a los enfermos en familia para compartir el mensaje de misericordia y compasión que Jesús nos muestra en este momento tan especial. 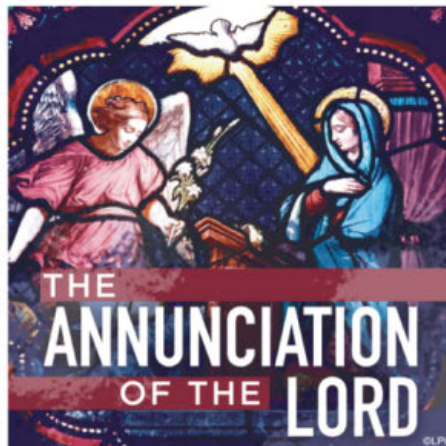

## LITURGICAL FOCUS

### The Annunciation of the Lord

The Solemnity of the Annunciation, celebrated on April 8th, honors the profound meeting between God through His Archangel Gabriel and the Virgin Mary, as recorded in St. Luke's Gospel. On this day St. Gabriel announced to Mary Immaculate that she would miraculously conceive a Child by the Holy Spirit, the long-awaited Messiah who would save mankind from their sins. This is the moment of the Blessed Virgin Mary's great act of perfect submission to the Divine will. This day on which the Church celebrates the Incarnation of Jesus Christ in the womb of His Blessed Mother is exactly nine months before the Feast of the Nativity on December 25th.

(\*Normally celebrated March 25, this year moved to April 8 due to Holy Week.)

En este día, San Gabriel anunció a María Inmaculada que ella concebiría milagrosamente a un Niño por el Espíritu Santo, el Mesías tan esperado que salvaría a la humanidad de sus pecados. Este es el momento del gran acto de la Santísima Virgen María de perfecta sumisión a la voluntad Divina. Este día en el que la Iglesia celebra la Encarnación de Jesucristo en el vientre de su Santísima Madre es exactamente nueve meses antes de la Fiesta de la Natividad el 25 de diciembre.
