Please place the completed form in an envelope with Jim Borden's name and the words "Scholarship Application" on the outside. You can turn the envelope into the office, give it to an usher with a Knight's nametag (they will place it in our mailbox in the Sacristy), or place it on the table next to the office door. You can also email me the completed form with "Scholarship Application" as the subject.

There are 2 awards that each young man and young woman are eligible (note: that you do not need to have a father or family member as a Knight). We are limiting this to high school seniors for this award.

Our council: 11042 based out of Church of the Redeemer will select one male and one female will be selected for an award of \$1,000 each and all applicants will be notified of the results in April of 2018. The formal recognition and presentation of the scholarship stipends will take place at a Council event prior to the student's departure for college.

The winners will also be sent to the state for the state young man and young woman.

Criteria that we are looking for in selecting the winners:

1. Outstanding contribution(s) made by the nominee.
2. Academic excellence.
3. Involvement in civic, religious and/or school-related programs.
4. Participation in extracurricular activities.
5. Special achievements - Any awards/recognition received.
6. Participation with his/her family in performing any of the above.

1. **Brother Knight Financial Need Program:** Brother Knights in good standing and their wives, or the widows of brother Knights, who resided in Virginia at time of death and were in good standing, can apply for a scholarship to assist them in their educational goals.
2. **High School Graduate Program:** Annual competition is among eligible graduating High School Seniors who are going on to higher education in the fall. This program is open to all children of Knights who are in good standing in a council in Virginia, or were in good standing at the time of death. Scholarship awards under this category will be based on the whole person and the financial status of the applicant.

**Special Note: Members of Columbian Squires and Columbian Squire Roses in good standing in a Circle in Virginia are able to apply even though their father or grandfather may not be a member of the Knights of Columbus.**

**Applications will be accepted between 2018 JAN 01 and 2018 MAR 31.** More information and the applications will be placed on the State Website.
