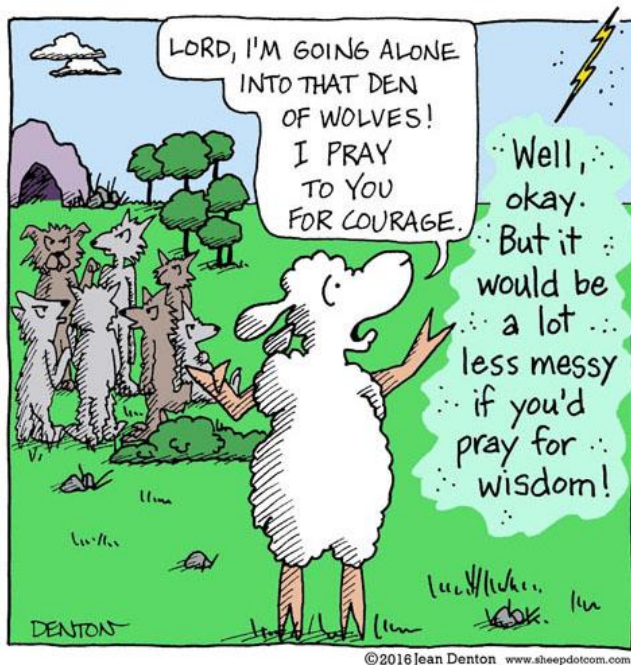

Advent thought for today: In difficult moments, remember God is with you, and trust in his promise to save you from harm.

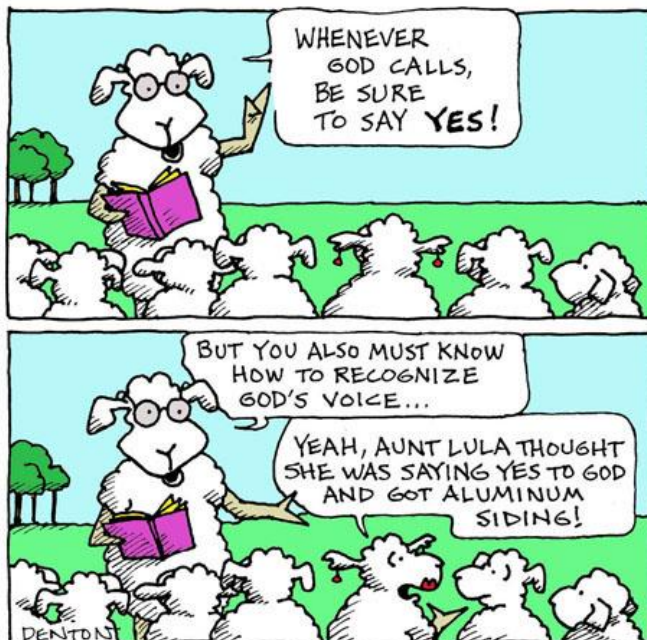
December 5 – "He shall govern your people with justice and your afflicted ones with judgment." --Psalm 72:2

Advent thought for today: Be compassionate and concerned about others' needs and you'll discover the peace that Jesus holds.

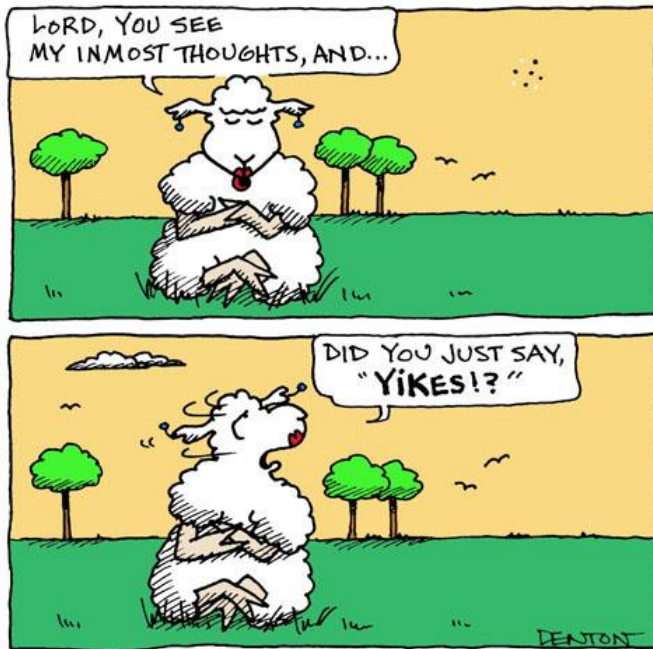
December 6 – "He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him." --Matthew 4:22
