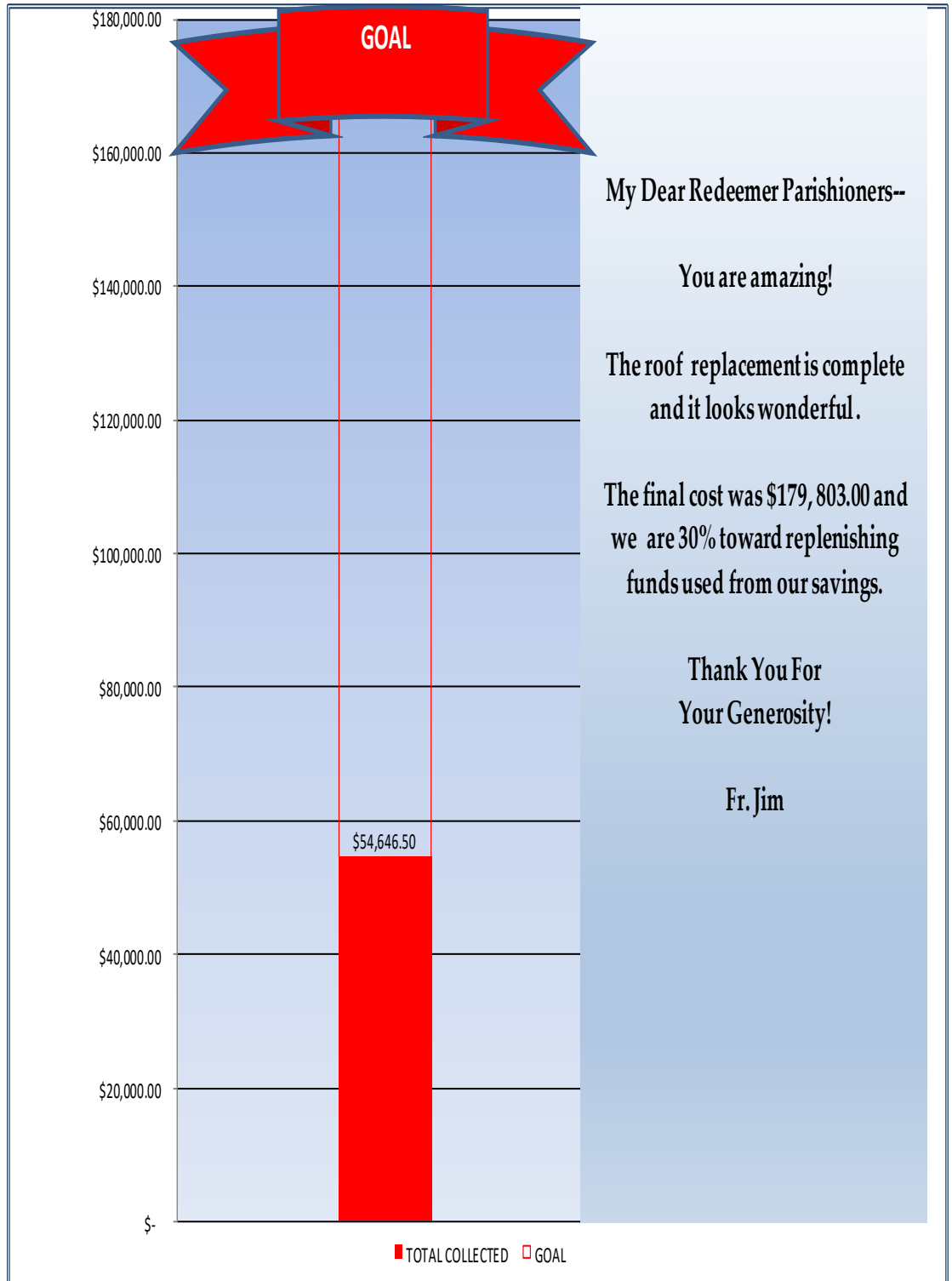

Sargent Reynolds, before pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Virginia Tech;

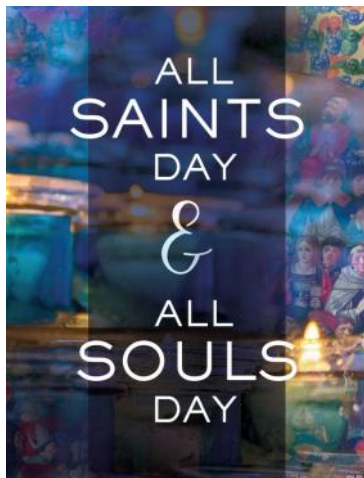


Display Your Nativity at No Room at the Inn
