#### Liaison Reports

- Finance Council – Tom said that the sky lights are fixed. We received our first installment check of \$18,000 from the diocese for repairing the building. Regina is working on the parking lot. We are going to receive new accounting software – entering expenses. We are ahead of budget in collections. Next 3 to 4 months straighten out the new payroll system. Was concerned about the collection of the Feast of Assumption in the bulletin.
- RE and Youth – Terry still looking for RE catechists. The four applicants were not qualified or cancelled. Fr Jay asked other parishes for their applicants that were not considered. Maria Harris volunteered to be on the select committee. Gabriel Worthington, youth representative to PC, said the Youth Council will meet with Terry and then the Youth Council will work on some Youth RE sessions.
