- Human Concerns – The report provided a good update on activities of Social Justice ministries. It was suggested that we somehow bring to the attention of the parish the Social Justice Update. Some recommendations were in homily and bulletin. Subject was tabled. This may be an evangelization area.

- Looking for volunteers for welcoming committee.
- The building improvement plan will be taken to the Diocese during the week of Jul 30. The improvement plans with present competing capital projects for the parish repairs (roof, skylights, speakers) vs. improvements. Any concerns about improvements should be re-directed to Fr. Jay.
- The parish has advertised for a Youth Minister. The advertisement is slated to close on July 31. A search committee will be created that will be led by Terry Coleville. Leroy's last day is August 2. It was suggested that the parish plan a celebration for Leroy.
- Finance Council Liaison – (Tom &) Rob reviews cost on church repairs: skylights, speakers, dehumidifier, estimate on roof. Looking into replacing skylights altogether. Current inclination is to repair the skylights and then pursue replacements
