It has come to my attention that some parents have not worked their assigned time in the concessions stand. Missing a shift is not fair to those parents who work their scheduled time, because it leaves them short-handed and requires an even greater time commitment on their part to clean up after an event. As a family whose child participates in the St. Mary's athletic program, you are required to work concession shifts to maintain your child's eligibility to participate.

Concession sales and admissions are the main source of funds used to maintain the cost of the athletic program. These revenues help provide our teams with uniforms, equipment, referees, and fees for tournaments that our teams attend. Without this income, the cost for your child to participate in the athletic program would increase substantially. The athletic program is counting on each of you to help make the program successful by doing your part and working your assigned concession shifts.

Failure to fulfill your assigned concession duty will result in a \$75 surcharge for future participation in the program.
