Volunteer Opportunities

Receptionists (Training provided)

A Receptionist is the first person our client sees and sets the tone for a welcoming, confidential visit. The receptionist provides smooth office operations by answering the phone, making appointments, and assisting with light clerical work as needed.

Client Advocates (Training provided)

A Client Advocate reaches out to women with the compassion of Christ by offering pro-life, practical assistance in both word and deed as a one-on-one caring helper. They listen, educate, intervene with communication skills, and provide a source of physical, emotional, and spiritual hope for women in an unplanned pregnancy that seek our free services.

Registered Nurses (Ultrasound training provided)

A Nurse Sonographer supports medical services at the center by performing limited obstetric ultrasounds to determine gestational age, detect a fetal heartbeat, verify the pregnancy, and by providing medical and education services to the clients.
