

SCBA COVID-19 Protocols  
Effective January 2022

As of 1/3/2022, masks will be optional for scholars, teachers, staff and visitors of Saint Charles Borromeo Academy.

If a person in the building tests positive for COVID-19, SCBA will follow the guidelines below:

- A person who tests positive will need to isolate themselves from others. The person will not be allowed back at school for at least 5 days.
- After 5 days, if the person has no symptoms, they can return to school/work - but need to be masked 100% of the time for the next 5 days.

**If someone at SCBA is exposed to COVID-19, SCBA will follow the following guidelines:**

If you:

Have been boosted

OR

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months

- Wear a mask around others for 10 days.
- Test on day 5, if possible.

*If you develop symptoms, get a test and stay home.*

If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine **over 6 months ago and are not boosted**

OR

Completed the primary series of J&J **over 2 months ago and are not boosted**

OR

Are unvaccinated

- Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.
- Test on day 5 if possible.

*If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home*
