### Children's Liturgy of the Word



Children's Liturgy of the Word is an age-appropriate Liturgy of the Word offered for elementary aged children at the 10:30am Mass. No pre-registration is necessary. All children are welcome and encouraged to attend.

Just before the Liturgy of the Word begins for the assembly, these children are invited to go with the weekly leaders from the church to the lower level. During this special time, the adult or teen minister leads the children through prayers, songs and readings that are simplified for children.

The children learn about the same Scripture readings as the rest of the assembly. They are taught a simplified main message of the readings and are encouraged to share that message with their parents after Mass.

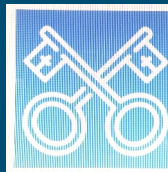
