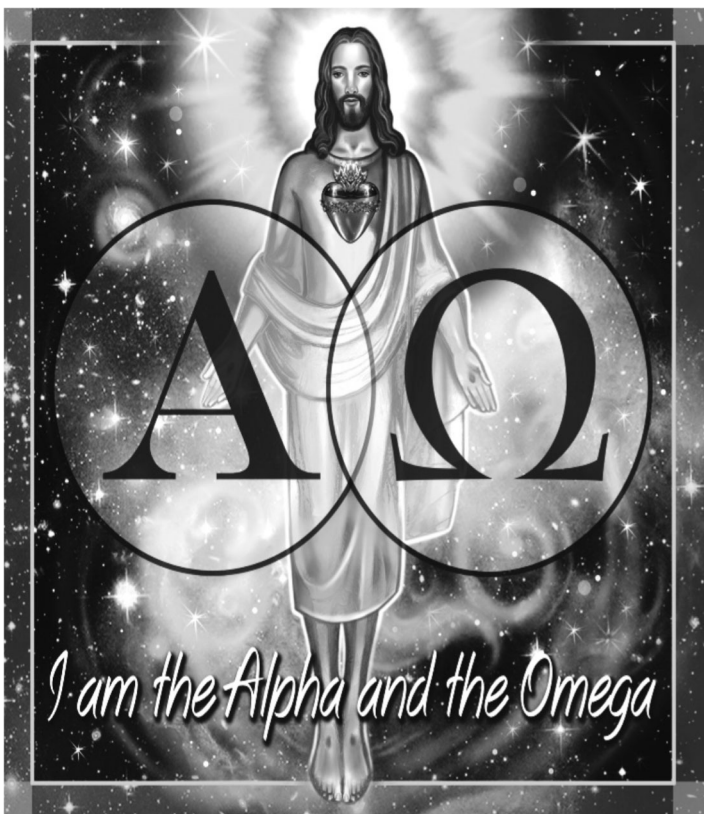
### MARRIAGE

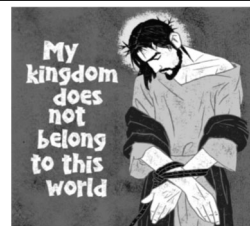
