St. Michael Parish, Whittemore, is offering a tuition grant to subsidize parishioners who are sending children to Catholic schools.

WHO QUALIFIES?

Those who qualify must be attending a Catholic school. Anyone in grades K-12 who qualifies for free or reduced lunch is eligible. The student must participate in one parish activity on a regular basis. (e.g. serving, cantoring, organist, youth group, etc.)

SIZE OF GRANT:

Each qualifying student will receive a grant amount to be determined by how many applicants there are and how much money is available to be used for tuition grant assistance. Grant money will be sent directly to the Catholic school they are attending and will be credited to their tuition account.

SOURCE OF REVENUE:

The Annual Lenten Fish Fry proceeds along with breakfasts and donations from parishioners and others is the source of St. Michael's Tuition Assistance Fund.

WHO DETERMINES GRANTS?

All grants will be confidential. They will be determined by the pastor and the parish finance council but **no** names are given to the council.
