

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends In Christ.

We have been blessed with truly wonderful weather this mid fall. I truly find myself seeing God's handiwork during times like these. 

# **Donate Tax Free** From Your IRA

Did you know you can give from your IRA to St. John the Baptist without having to pay income taxes on the money? This is called an IRA charitable rollover gualified charitable distribution (QCD). Beginning in 2023, when you turn 73, you can use your gift to satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution (RMD). (In 2019, the trigger was set at the age of Gifts of any value of \$100,000 or less are eligible for this benefit and you can feel good knowing that you are making a difference in your parish. Contact your retirement provider to get started.
