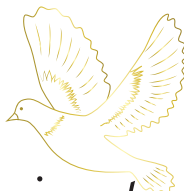

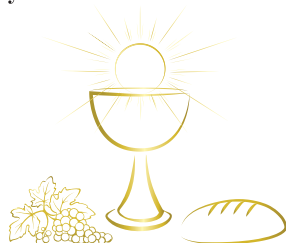

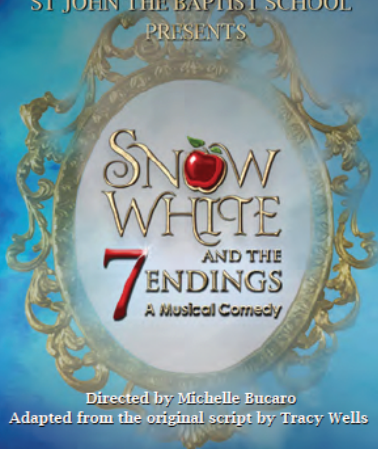
St. John the Baptist Catholic School's Children's Annual Appeal
