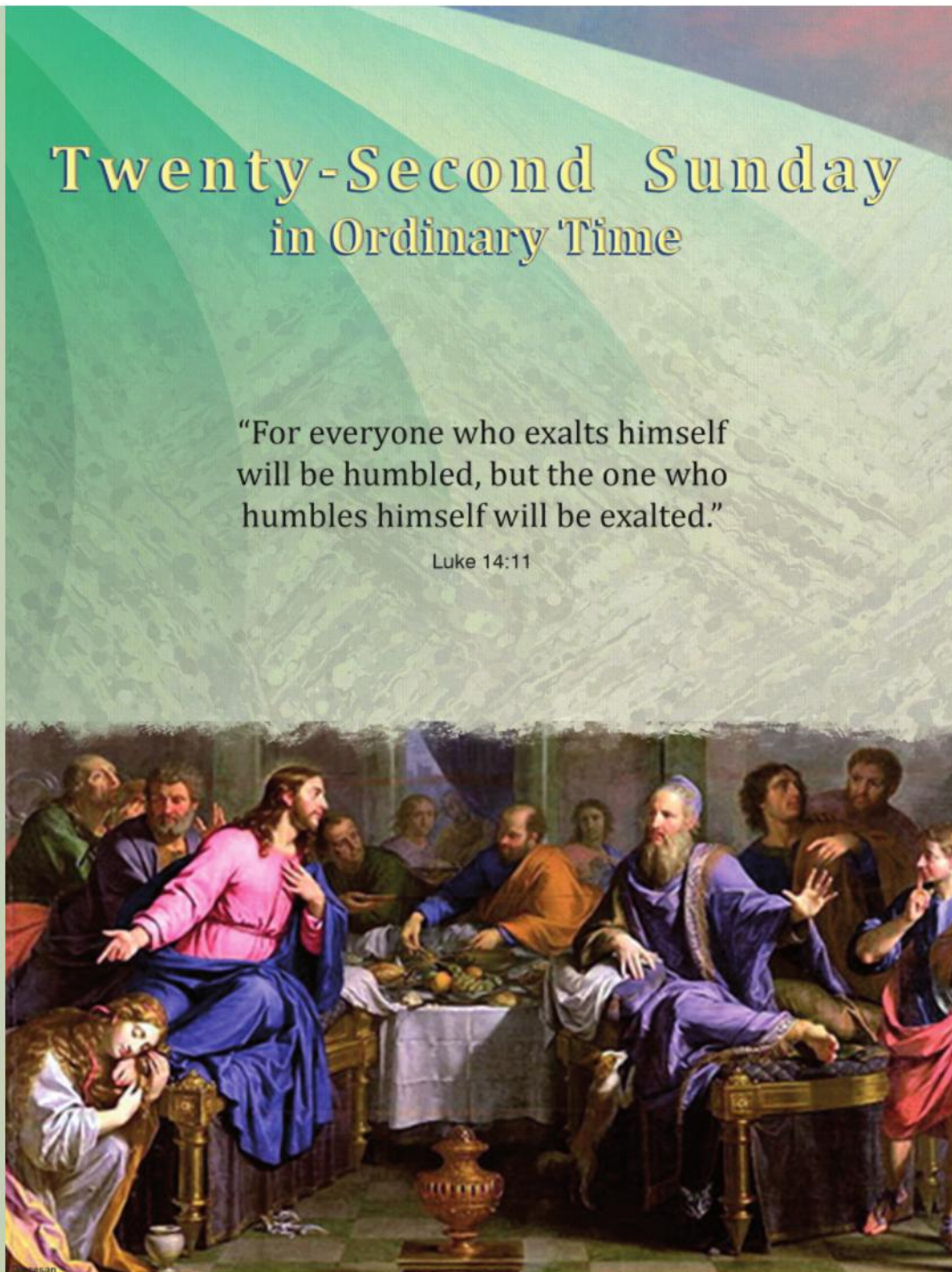

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Our beloved Council of Catholic Women (CCW) here at St. John's is part of an organization that was founded in 1920 when the U.S. Catholic Bishops, who had seen the good work accomplished by many separate Catholic women's groups during World War 1, urged parish women's organizations to unite their efforts by forming a federation of 7,000 Catholic women's organizations across the country. Henceforth, the National Council of Catholic Women acts to support, empower and educate all Catholic women in spirituality, leadership and service. In the fall of 1964, the Bishop of our diocese made a similar request to parish women's organizations to unite their efforts and, together, St. Mary's Sodality of St. John's and the Mother's Club of our St. John's School became known as St. John the Baptist Council of Catholic Women.

I am so appreciative of our St. John's CCW. Even in the short time I've been here, I have gotten to see CCW host various parish receptions, say the Rosary on First Saturdays, sponsor activities for Winfield Woods, and donate to the needy of the parish.

Baptisms

Baptisms are held on Saturdays. Parents need to be registered parishioners for at least six months and parents will need to attend a Baptism Preparation Class prior to the Baptism. Godparents are to be practicing Catholics! If Godparents are married, their marriage needs to be blessed by the Catholic Church. Please contact the parish office, 630-668-0918, 600.

RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults)

Our RCIA classes are for any adult wanting to become Catholic. This is the time when questions are answered and formation begins.
