FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends in Christ.

I'd like to welcome Abby Sheaffer, our new director of communications who started at St. John's last week. Below is a letter from Abby:

In Christ, Fr Chris

My name is Abby Sheaffer and it is my honor to be your new Director of Communications. This position means a great deal to me because my Grammy was a lifelong parishioner of St. John The Baptist.

When my Grandpa died when my mom was 16, my Granmy took on the role of St. John The Baptist's parish bookkeeper. She held onto the position while raising nine children by herself. She relished the role so much, she stayed on for 30 years.

My journey to your parish began after I lost my mom last summer to pancreatic cancer. I moved back in and worked as my mother's caregiver, trying to make her transition to Heaven as tranquil and comfortable as I possibly could.



Grief is something to contend with. I won't even begin to wrap it up neatly with a bow.

After my mom's passing, I would take long walks and pray. I would always say a "Hail Mary" and pray to my mom and my Grammy. I told them I was looking for work, and that I'd ideally like to do what my Grammy did, have the sort of career that she did.

God listens.

I did not expect to go on Indeed and see that my dream job would be available. I threw my hat in the ring because I feel I owed to myself, to my Grammy's legacy. I did not expect to hear back for an interview, but I did. I did not expect to get called back for the second round of interviews, but I did.

When I got the job, I cried tears of joy.

My father says it's Divine Intercession on behalf of my mom and my Grammy.

I believe him. I spent the whole of my twenties as a sullen atheist, never believing in the miracles I saw around me. I blinded myself with doubt.

But I can't doubt God anymore. Not when he brought me back to my Grammy's parish, to work as she worked.

That is Divine Intercession.

DIOCESAN FORTY HOURS DEVOTION

Our diocesan church will gather on Feb. 8-10 to celebrate a time of spiritual devotion before the Blessed Sacrament during this diocesan year of the National Eucharistic Revival.

Our Forty Hours Devotion will take place at the Cathedral of St. Raymond Nonnatus in Joliet. It will begin each day with a morning Mass and conclude with a prayer service in the evening. Throughout the day there will be silent adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, and at various times during the day there will be communal prayer services.

The basic schedule will be the same each day – morning Mass on Wed., Feb. 8 at 6:30 a.m.; morning Mass on Thurs., Feb. 9 at 8 a.m.; and morning Mass on Fri., Feb. 10 at 8 a.m. With the conclusion of morning Mass and until the 8 p.m. prayer service, the cathedral will be open for individuals to spend time in silent adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Communal prayer services will take place at 11 a.m., 2 p.m., 5 p.m. and 8 p.m., and will be led by various priests of the diocese, cultural groups, needs groups, school children and diocesan employees. A listing of the prayer service leaders will be sent out soon. After the 8 p.m. service, the Blessed Sacrament will be reposed for the day.

We encourage all people to come and reflect in prayer on the wondrous gift of the Eucharist. We encourage parish groups – OCIA process groups, prayer groups, Bible study groups, Council of Catholic Women, Knights of Columbus, women's and men's organizations, young adult groups, high school groups, etc.) to come and spend time together praying for the needs of their parish, their families and their neighbors.


