

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends in Christ,

Last week I talked about Lent being the season for us to focus on praying, fasting and almsgiving, as we prepare for the day we will celebrate that our Lord, Jesus Christ, has Risen for us. This week I would like to talk about reconciliation.

In previous messages, I have talked about the power of reconciliation. God loves us so much, that if we are truly repentant for our sins, He is ready and willing to forgive us. And, since we will soon be celebrating that God gave up His only Son for us, this is a wonderful time of year to prepare our hearts for His selfless love, and take part in the sacrament of reconciliation.

As I have also mentioned in the past, if it has been awhile since you last went to confession, please do not let any fear or discomfort keep you away from this wonderful gift from our Lord. Taking part in this sacrament is an important part of our faith, even for priests (yes, me too!). If you have any questions, please ask. It's our job to help Lead Souls to Heaven.

LENTEN GUIDELINES

Fast and Abstinence Regulations:

- 1. Everyone 14 years of age or over is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.
- 2. Everyone 18 years of age and under 59 years of age is bound to fast and to abstain on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
- 3. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meatless meal is allowed. Two other meatless meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted on these two days, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.
- 4. To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful.
- 5. Lent is the principal season of penance in the Christian year; all, in addition to following the Lenten regulations, are strongly urged to develop and follow a program of voluntary self-denial, serious prayer, and a performance of works of charity and mercy.




