

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends In Christ,

I'd like to start by giving a shout out to you, the people of St. John's, the Knights of Columbus and CCW. I was unable to attend Fr. Alex's going away bash due to my canonical retreat, but my understanding was that it was very, very well attended, both a tribute to Fr. Alex and to you, who are always so gracious with your support. And, we had our Knights and CCW ladies that did their usual stellar job of handling the food, sides and desserts for such a crowd. No surprise there. Thank you all!

Last week I promised to share additional information about some of the new faces that you will see around campus. This week I'm going to share some information about our new Director of Liturgical Life, Michael Berger. Michael hasn't wasted anytime jumping right in and putting some of his touches in place. For some time, we have been considering ways to upgrade our sound system in the church. There are still plans for substantial, contemporary improvements to our old, existing sound system, but in the interim, I think you'll find the modest



changes Mike has already made to increase the quality and projection of our sound capabilities helpful.

As for Michael (or Mike) himself, he has been a liturgical musician since 2010 starting at his home parish of St. Teresa of the Child Jesus in Kankakee, IL. He began as a cantor, then worked his way into subbing as the Sunday musician on the organ and piano. For the better part of the last two years he has been the Director of Sacred Music at St. Mary's in Mokena. Prior to that, in 2017 he served on the committee to help merge churches as part of the Diocesan Catholic Churches of Kankakee. The work of the committee helped create a merger of churches into St. John Paul II Catholic Parish, where Mike served as the Music Director until September of 2021. In 2016, he began work as the Music Director of St Martin of Tours Catholic Church, and St Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Kankakee, playing a variety of liturgical pieces and singing. He is also a composer of liturgical works that he uses at Mass.

Michael is married to his wife Candice, and they live together in Chebanse, IL., along with their son, Michael Berger, Jr. In his spare time, Michael enjoys repairing computers and being a DJ.






