

Dear Friends in Christ,

Wow! What a busy week we have had at St. John's! We had the feast day of my favorite Saint, St. Maximilian Kolbe, we had the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and we had the first day of school and all our other regularly scheduled activities. What a great week, but a fast week!

I'm so happy to welcome back all our schoolchildren for another school year! As of writing this article, we have an enrollment of 209 at St. John the Baptist Catholic Grade School! PRAISE GOD FOR THAT! When I arrived we were only at 134 children. To have an increase of 75 is amazing! I'm so proud of our principal, Ms. Joanne Policht, our school administrative assistant, Teri Hardesty, and all our teachers and staff for all the hard work they put in to make St. John's the best Catholic school in the Diocese! Without them, the volunteers, and such a supportive community, we wouldn't have the numbers we have, but more importantly, we wouldn't have 209 children being led to Heaven!

I'm also very excited about a new Religious Education option that is going to be running parallel to the traditional RE classes this year. We are introducing Catechesis of the Good Shepherd at St. John's! It's an amazing opportunity for our children to have a Montessori-based model of RE and to really have a hands-on approach to learning the faith. When I witnessed CGS in person, it was INCREDIBLE! I'm so thankful to Sarah Reznicek, our new Director of Faith Formation for all the hard work she is putting in to get this program up and running. God willing we will start in early October! A shout out to Maureen Brennan as well, with all her hard work she made it possible to run both programs parallel this year, and I know she is such a continual valuable resource for Sarah.

Thank you so much to everyone who donated to the AC second collection last week and this week. With your generosity, we should be able to purchase the appropriate unit for the Church soon! As we get more bids in and are ready to make a decision, I'll inform you of the exact costs and timelines for the AC in the Church.



Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

The Illinois tax credit scholarship program has proven to be a beacon of hope and a guiding force toward a better life for thousands of Illinois students and their families. However, that light may be snuffed out unless the Illinois General Assembly acts to continue the law that provides for this program. Therefore, we are writing to ask you to contact your Illinois state representative and state senator to express your desire to retain the tax credit scholarship program.

Since its inception six years ago, the tax credit scholarship program has generated overwhelmingly positive results. Nearly 40,000 scholarships have been awarded to students attending private schools in the state. These scholarships are funded through contributions from donors who receive a 75% tax credit for their donation on their Illinois state income tax. All of the scholarships are need-based. Without this program, Illinois families may be unable to send their loved ones to the school of their choice. Demand for scholarships is high - for every scholarship granted, three students were turned down due to lack of funds.

Allowing the tax credit scholarship program to sunset would not only be a life altering disservice to the families it is designed to help, but would also create long-term consequences by weakening the state's educational choices and placing additional roadblocks in front of thousands of Illinois students on the path to a brighter future.

Please contact your state representative and state senator to let them know you support extending the tax credit scholarship program in Illinois law. We also encourage you to urge your fellow parishioners to do so also. Our collective voice is needed. 


KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS SNACK SHACK OPEN!


