

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends In Christ,

"Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me.

For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."



As I was reflecting on these key passages of the Gospel this week, I was struck by both the simplicity of the message, yet the difficulty in carrying it out. This has been true since the time of our Lord. As we all know, during his adult life it wouldn't be long before Jesus predicted that Peter would deny he knew Jesus three times in one night, just before his Crucifixion. This was seemingly an easy task. Although, in all fairness to Peter, his life was probably literally on the line.

For our day and time we might be able to boil it down to a similar message. "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you." This seems like such a reasonable tenet to live by, but in reality, it isn't easy. It's hard. And, you have to work at it, and work at it all the time. Trying to follow Jesus, and not doing things for your own personal glory or benefit requires discipline and sacrifice. Do we really lend a helping hand when asked? How many times have we been selfish driving on the road, or impatient with somebody who isn't driving the way we would like them to drive? Do we really pray to God with conviction, and the frequency with which we should? Some of these examples may be more important than others, but the point is, if you are human like I am, there is always room for improvement in many areas. We need to keep working at it, and keep praying for God's assistance. Fortunately, we also get to rely on His grace in the form of reconciliation when we come up short.


