

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Friends In Christ,

As promised, I'd like to share a little bit of information with you about our new parochial vicar, Fr. John Abulag. Father John was born John Ronaldo Gabutan Abulag in Talisayan Misamis, Oriental, Phillipines. That was the town his mother came from. His birth date is March 31st, if you want to add it to your calendars. I'm going to protect his birth year – you know, all these privacy regulations we have to follow. One month later, in the same town, Fr. John was baptized at the Church of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Afterwards, he was born and raised in the city of Gingoog, which was his dad's town.

Interestingly, Father John was named after two people. His grandfather's name was John, and he gets his middle name from a man named Ronaldo Valdez, who apparently was a very famous actor way back in the day. Father John comes from a large family. He has five brothers and one sister, plus an adopted sister who was a niece of his dad, and an adopted brother, who was a nephew of his mom. In the household, Father is referred to as John-John.

For kindergarten through high school he attended public school, but did attend a catholic college, where he received a bachelor of science in commerce, with his major being management. After first working as a curator in a painting gallery, and teaching high school Christian Living as well as philosophy, his true journey took off. He received a philosophy degree at Our Lady of the Angels Franciscan Seminary in Quezon City, and completed his theology studies at Santo Tomas-Recoletos in Manila. Father John has a number of passions, including ministering to the deaf. He first met the Dominican Missionaries for the Apostolates of the Deaf in 2011. And, in his own words, he has been a die-hard member of the Legion of Mary since high school. In fact, he is presently the spiritual director of the Legion of Mary in Joliet. He would later become a deacon in December of 2020, and was ordained to the priesthood on May 22, 2021.

Like many of us, Father John has also had to persevere through some adversity. He lost his mom on his first day of final exams in his theology program, and his dad passed away the day before he was ordained. He still tries to keep a positive attitude, about even that difficult year. He is very proud of his heritage, and although his dad passed, in 2021 the Philippines celebrated 500 years of Christianity. Also, May 22nd was the feast day of St. Rita of Cascia who he considers to be his ordination saint, one of a long list of saints he admires and respects, including Sts. Pope John Paul II and Mother Teresa.

For a little trivia, Fr. John loves sweets, his favorite colors are blue, red, green and black, he likes to listen to music, does a little singing, and get this – he likes to watch horror movies. Finally, Father John hasn't been back to the Philippines since first arriving in Joliet, and is hopeful he can do that sometime next year to see his family and their families. In the meantime, he is very excited to be at St. John's and is looking forward to meeting as many of you as possible. Welcome Fr. John!



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We, the Catholic bishops of Illinois, write with a sense of urgency. Unless the General Assembly acts to renew the Invest in Kids scholarship program, more than 9,000 children currently relying on this program to attend a non-public school may have their educational path disrupted. Without an extension of the program in Illinois law now, no scholarships will be awarded for the school year that will begin in September 2024. Most of these children will have to leave the school their families determined was their best chance to receive a high-quality education in a safe and wholesome learning environment. This is an injustice that should and can be avoided, but only if the General Assembly acts when it reconvenes on October 24, 2023.

Invest in Kids has proven to be a beacon of hope for thousands of Illinois students and their families. Children receiving Invest in Kids scholarships come from lower-income families who could not otherwise afford tuition at the Catholic or another non-public school that is the best fit for their child. Childhood is a limited time in the life of a human being and primary and secondary education is not something that can be put off to some future date when it is convenient for adults. This is our one chance to offer these Illinois children a good start. Please help keep education options available and a brighter future possible by contacting your state senator and state representative and telling them to continue the Invest in Kids Program.

Since its inception six years ago, Invest in Kids has generated overwhelmingly positive results. Nearly 40,000 scholarships have been awarded to students attending non-public schools across Illinois. Demand for scholarships is very high - for every scholarship granted, three students are turned down due to lack of funds. Contrary to what you may have heard, this is not a voucher program, nor does it take state funds away from the public schools. These scholarships are funded through contributions from donors who receive a tax credit for their donation on their Illinois state income tax.

What can you do to help? Please contact your state senator and state representative to let them know of your support for extending the Invest in Kids tax credit scholarship program in Illinois. We also encourage you to urge your fellow parishioners to do the same. Our collective voice is vital to the continued help for Illinois families.
