

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Friends in Christ,

BRRRRRR!

It certainly has been cold recently, and I hope and pray everyone has been staying warm! I know I've been staying inside a lot more than normal due to the extreme temperatures, and Cal has too. Many people ask me if he likes the snow and cold. He does! However, even this is too cold for him. He would rather take a nap (see picture below).



I'm very excited for Catholic Schools week in just a few weeks. It's a chance to celebrate the benefit of Catholic Education and also to promote our parish school! We are so blessed to have a thriving grade school at St. John's. We currently, as of the writing of this article, have 215 young boys and girls having their souls Led to Heaven in our parish school, which is incredible! That's an increase of 81 children since my arrival as your pastor.

A reality I must bring to your attention as a parish family is the sunset of the Empower Illinois Tax Credit Program. After this school year, those scholarships will not be available for our children. We have currently over 70 of our students on these scholarships totaling over \$350,000 of scholarship money. That means in order to keep these 70 children in our school we need to fill a \$350,000 gap. This is on top of the \$210,000 of parish subsidy our Church made to the grade school in the 2022–2023 fiscal year, and is preparing to make again for the 2023–2024 school year. Combined this number is \$560,000.

If we want to keep all of our current children in our school (supporting those who are losing their scholarships after this school year), and factoring in operations costs to run the school (which the parish subsidy helps offset), we need to come up with a <u>sustainable</u> solution that will last into the future. Half of a million dollars isn't an easy number to come up with every year.

So I'm asking for your help. If you're able to contribute in any way to our **Msgr. Cloos Fund**, these dollars will **100**% go to funding our needy students <u>tuition expenses</u> that will be incurred from the loss of their scholarships, and for those who truly qualify for financial aide. We will try to help as many students as

we can with the resources we come up with.

If you have a capacity to make a more substantial donation and would like to meet with me or our principal on how you can help give scholarships to needy students or help with funding the operations of our school, or have a longer term financial solution you can help offer, I know myself and Joanne are more than willing to have those conversations, so please let us know!

My goal is to be able to have every child who wants to be at our school, be at our school. Will you help me Lead Their Souls to Heaven?

Donate Tax Free From Your IRA

Did you know you can give from your IRA to St. John the Baptist without having to pay income taxes on the money? This is called an IRA charitable rollover or qualified charitable distribution (QCD), which you can begin to make when you turn 70 1/2 years old. And, you can use your gift to satisfy all or part of your required minimum distribution (RMD) if you turn 73 in 2023. (In 2019, this trigger was set at the age of 72). Gifts of any value of \$100,000 or less are eligible for this benefit. For married couples, each spouse can donate up to \$100,000. 
