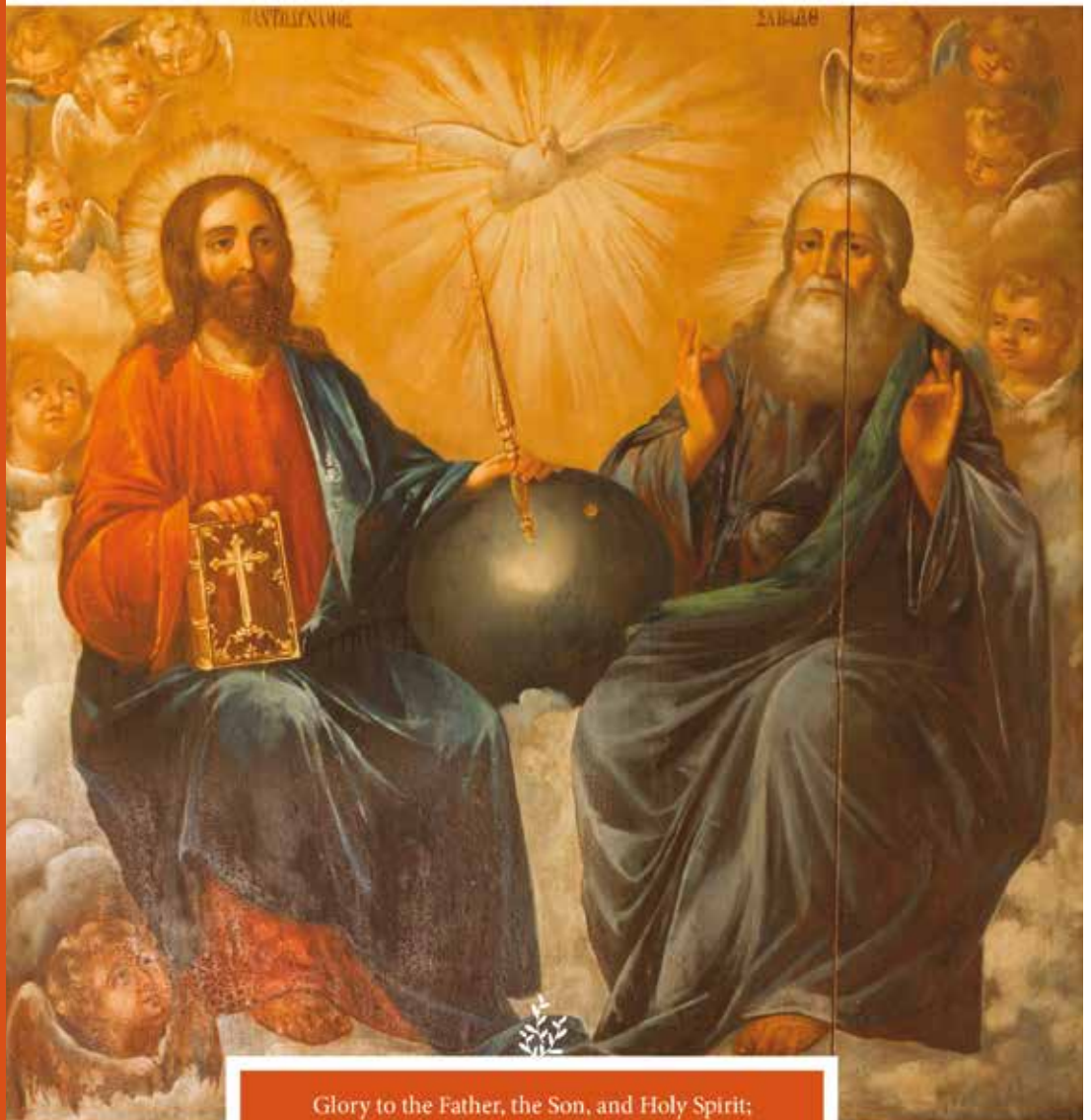

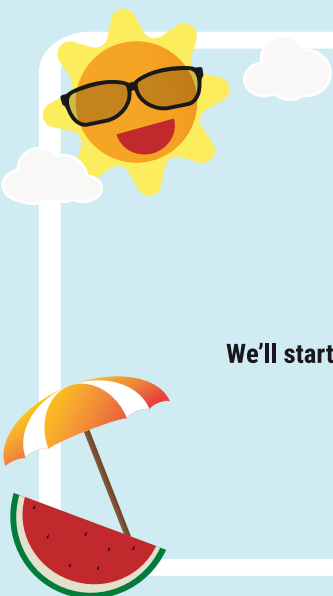

Baptisms
