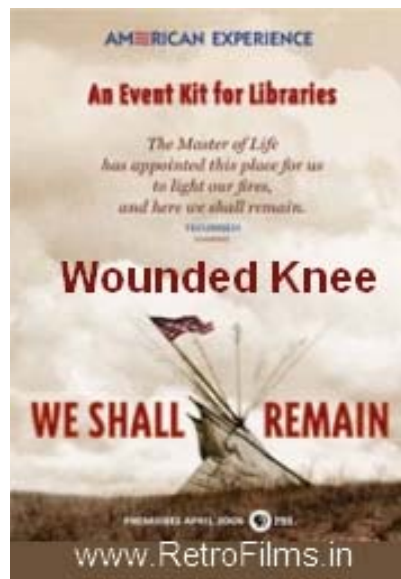
## Please join us!
