



# St. Mary & St. John the Baptist Catholic Cemeteries

Whether you plan for a traditional burial or the interment of cremains,  
St. Mary & St. John the Baptist Cemeteries offer an option to suit your needs.

### Family Lot

A family lot is sold as four or more plots to a family. These plots allow for a single

monument to be placed centrally on the lot and engraved with each family member's name.

### Companion Plot

Companion plots are available as two side-by-side burials, usually for husband and wife. This type of grave will have a single marker or monument centered between the two plots.

### Single Plot

Burial rights are available individually and can be used for full burial or cremation.



### Columbarium Niche

Our columbaria offer above-ground interment of cremated remains in a physical location for family and friends to visit. Niches are available both as single and companion niches. Placement in a columbarium can be an elegant and economical option for you and your loved ones.

### Cremation Plot

A new addition to our cemeteries, the Rosary Garden presents a place for prayer and meditation and is exclusively for the interment of cremated remains. Framed by the beautiful statue of Mary, each rosary bead marker is included with the purchase of a plot in this section. There are additional opportunities available to memorialize your loved ones through the donation of benches and monuments.

St. Mary Cemetery consists of 22 acres with mature trees in a park-like setting. The original parcel of land for this cemetery was purchased for the parish in 1880, and substantial acreage was added to the property in 1931. The cemetery features picturesque grottos of Mary and St. Francis of Assisi, there is also a lovely chapel built in 1958, which was dedicated to the memory of Monsignor John Hummel, long-time pastor of the parish. The massive stone gates were repaired and restored in 2019

Known locally as St. John Cemetery No. 1, the property was purchased by Father Wiercinski for the parish in 1896. This cemetery features a beautiful crucifixion group that was added in 1952.

St. John Cemetery No. 2 was donated to the parish in May 1895. The majestic statue of the Guardian Angel that stood outside the grade school for many years was relocated here in 2011, and is a focal point at this peaceful location.
