Whoever Receives Me

The tail end of our Gospel today is a bit puzzling:

Whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward, and whoever receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive a righteous man's reward. And whoever gives only a cup of cold water to one of these little ones to drink because the little one is a disciple... (Mt 10:41-42)

The implication here is that we ought to be hospitable to prophets *because* they are prophets and to help righteous people *because* they are righteous.

So, should we give water to a thirsty disciple *because* he is a disciple? Shouldn't we just be kind, hospitable and hydrating to all? What's going on here? As is often the case, lurking under these verses is a piece of first century Jewish culture that is easy to miss. Jewish tradition at the time of Jesus held that a *shaliah* (שליח) or ambassador possessed all the authority of the one who sent him. The Catholic Commentary on Sacred Scripture explains it this way:

"A man's emissary...is like the man himself." The Apostles do not teach on their own authority. Behind their preaching and healing is the authority of Jesus Christ himself. To accept the teaching of the apostles is to accept Jesus. But we can also see from the background of the shaliah that to reject the ministry of the apostles is no small matter. It is to reject Jesus.

As members of an apostolic Church we ought to take this message to heart. To reject the Church's clear teachings is to reject Christ. But to receive what our Church has to offer is to receive Christ himself.
